pair of Silver Snuff boxes and my Gold Sleeve Buttons to be delivered here
at the Age of Twenty one Years or day of Marriage which my first happen
Item I give and bequeath unto my Loving Wife Jane my two Negroes
Slave named Fortune and Susannah with her Offspring and Increase
and all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate whatsoever but if my
wife should be Consent or have a Mother Child, then I will that my whole Estate
be divided into three Parts, One third Part thereof I give to my son John
in manner aforesaid One other third Part to my said Wife and the remain
ing third Part to such Child whereof my Wife may be Consent and have
living. And I will that such my Child or Children be maintained & Educated
during their Minority out of the profits arising from their respective Shares
of my Estate And that they be not charged in any manner for their
Maintenance more than the proper and reasonable of their Share shall amount
to; And in case my Son and Wife dye before my Decease not having

9th other Issue of my Body then living I give one half of my Estate
to my Nephew Charles Hean of Philadelphia and his two Sisters
and the Remaining half of my Estate I give to my said Wives two
Heirs John William Hudson of New Castle upon Tyne or their
legal Representatives And I hereby Nominate and Appoint my said
Wife Jane Executrix and Mr William Popper Executor of this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and other Will and Wills
by me at any time heretofore made declaring this only to be my last Will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal the Thirtieth day of December In the Year of our Lord One
Thousand Seven Hundred and fifty five

and Testament is respectively mentioned and directed concerning the same
First I Will and Desire that all my just Debts and Chances be paid.
I Will and Order that all the rest Residue and
surplus of my Estate Real and Personal shall be kept together, Occupied, used and
improved to the best Advantage Profit use and behoof, Clothing & Maintenance
