Rest of my Estate to be equally divided between them I share &
Share alike to them and heirs Lastly I do Nominate constitute
and appoint my friend Thomas Sack everell to be my whole and
Sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby disallowing
disannulling and making void all other Wills and Testaments &
Legacies and bequeaths by me made or bequeathed Ratifying
Confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament
