ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following
that is to say first and Principally I resign My Soul into the hand
of Almighty God that made it & my Body I commit to be decently
interred at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named & as touching
what Worldly Estate I by Gods Providence now enjoy I dispose thereof
as follows. But first it is my Will that all my just Debts & funeral
Expences be all truly paid

Imprimis After all my Debts are paid I give & bequeath unto my
beloved Cousin Griffith Lewis in German Street in London & his Heirs
for ever the Remainder of my Estate with all my Rights Credits
except such as will be mention'd hereafter) But if he the said Griffith
Lewis is dead then I give & bequeath them unto my Beloved Uncle
Samuel Morgan & his Heirs forever

I do Hereby give & bequeath unto my beloved Father Lewis Jenkin
& his heirs forever all my Lands & Tenements in the Town of
Laugharne in Carmarthenshire in Wales and I do also renounce my
Claim to a Bond of Three Hundred pounds Sterling due from my said
Father Lewis Jenkin unto me

I also give unto Albert Ticherman planter of the aforesaid Parish
all the Furniture of my Bed Chamber as follows. The Bed & Linen belong-
ing to it. ibley. Chairs & a Bureau. I desire also that my Clothes &

Books may be Disposed of at the Discretion of my Executors. And
do hereby make & ordain constitute and appoint my Trusty Friends Stephen
Bull jun. of Sheldon & Benjamin Garden Executors to this my last will
& Testament. both of Prince William's Parish. Thereby request that they
fidelity settle my Affairs and revoke all former or other Wills by me at any time
made & do pronounce publish & Declare this to be my last Will & Testament.

wife should be Consent or have a Mother Child, then I will that my whole Estate
be divided into three Parts, One third Part thereof I give to my son John
in manner aforesaid One other third Part to my said Wife and the remain
ing third Part to such Child whereof my Wife may be Consent and have
living. And I will that such my Child or Children be maintained & Educated
during their Minority out of the profits arising from their respective Shares
of my Estate And that they be not charged in any manner for their
Maintenance more than the proper and reasonable of their Share shall amount
to; And in case my Son and Wife dye before my Decease not having
