I will and Bequeath all my Personal not yet Given away household Goods
battels Horses and Chattels of any sort whatever be Equally divided into
five parts between my dear beloved wife Martha, Isaac Fendin & Jacob
Fendin Abraham Fendin Dorcas Fendin soon after my Legacies and Just
debts are paid and not before to them their heirs and Assigns for ever And
I do hereby utterly Disallow revoke & Disannul all & every other former
Testaments wills Legacies and Requests and Exors before me in any way

of the Province aforesaid to commence Immediately after my decease & to
be paid to her in half yearly Payments, that is to say, the sum of One hundred
pounds to be paid to her two months after my decease and the like sum of
One hundred pounds Every six months after during the Time or Term of her
naturall Life Item: Chaire furniture & a suit of mourning, 2^d To my old
Mustee wench called Nanny I Give her freedom and as she is too old & pain-
labouring to Get her subsistence by working I likewise Give her the Ann-
Annual sum of twenty pounds Current money to be paid to her Personally
support during the time of her natural Life To Cathrine & Mary Mul-
lryne daughters of J. Mullryne to them and their heirs for ever, I Give &
Bequeath all my remaining part of, of a Tract of Land on Ladys Island
in the County aforesaid which was purchased of Thomas Lambolt of
Charles Town my self, To my Friends John Mullryne & I leave to each of
them arising commonly called a mourning ring with this Motto or Inscr-
ption To John Mullryne John Hutchinson to J. Mullryne Ill. to J. G. &
and so to each of them the rest and residue of my real and Personall I
Give & bequeath to my friend William Roher of Charles Town in the Province

 of my personal Estate together with the Tract of Land I now live upon to him
 and the heirs of his body for ever and in case my son Francis Oldfield should
 dye before he attains to the age of Twenty one Years then one half of the
 Personal Estate I left him to goe to his mother Susannah Oldfield and the other
 half of the Personal Estate to be equally divided between Sam^r. Sleigh Jun^r
 and Hugh Sleigh and the said above mentioned to goe to Sam^r. Sleigh Jun^r
 to him and heirs of his body for ever I do constitute and appoint my be-
 loved wife Susannah Oldfield and Sam^r. Sleigh & Hugh Sleigh my Executors and
 Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Ratifying and Confirming this
 and no other to be my Last Will and Testament, Revoking And disannulling
 all and every other will and Testaments
