Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister Mary Catto the sum of
One hundred pound Currency to be paid her at the Expiration of one
year after my decease and a suit of Mourning Item I give and be
queath unto my Brother Joseph Lloyd my Sword, Cuttis and Pistols
also all my Outside wearing Cloaths and Six compleat Pcs of my
Linnen Cloaths and also a suit of Mourning Item Whereas I am
possesed of a Large Quantity of household furniture and Plate more
than sufficient (In all Probability) for the Convenience of my wife &
daughter after my decease Therefore I will and desire that my Executors
and Executrix at their discretions do Sell such part thereof for the pay
ment of my debts or towards the same as they shall Judge most proper
Item I give devise and Bequeath unto my Dearly beloved Wife Rebecca
Lloyd and to my dearest Daughter Rebecca Lloyd all the rest and Residue
of my Estate Real and Personal whatsoever and wheresoever of what
Nature or Kind soever to hold the same to them and their Heirs Executors
and Administrators Equally to be divided And my will and mind is that
my Daughters share or part of my said Estate be delivered her at the age
of Twenty one Years or day of Marriage which shall first happen And
in case it should so happen that my said Daughter should depart this
Life before she attains her Age of Twenty One Years or day of Marriage
Then And in Such Case I give devise and Bequeath such part of my
Estate as is hereinbefore given to my said Daughter Equally to be divided
between my said wife and my Nephew Nathaniel Fuller & them and
their Respective Heirs Executors and Administrators for ever But in case my
said Nephew should happen to be dead at the time of such Contingency
happening or before his Age of Twenty One Years Then I give devise and
Bequeath the whole thereof to my said wife and to her heirs Executors and
Administrators for ever And I do Recommend unto said Executors and Executrix
that my Said Estate be carried on managed Occupied and Improved

100/ In the same way and manner that myself have done it for some
part to wit in the Planting & Improvement and increasing of stock during the
Daughters Minority or until the day of marriage And that after payment
of my Debt Maintenance and Support of wife and daughter and also my Da-
ughters Education and Other Incident and Necessary Charges and Expen-
ses of my Estate, the Profits Issues and proceeds thereof be Annually Ap-
plied One half to the use of my said Wife, and the other to my Daughters use
and Benefit as their Separate Interest and Estate And that my Executor
and Executor do keep particular and Separate Accounts thereof that each
party's Share may more clearly appear and leave it to the discretion of
my Executors either to put at Interest or such Security as they shall think
proper, or to purchase Slaves, with the monies that shall appear to be my
Daughters Share, as aforesaid And Lastly I do hereby nominate Constitute
and Appoint my said wife Executrix and my Brother in Law Mr. John
Freer Executor of this my will hereby revoking all former will by me at
any time made In witness whereof I have to this my Last Will and Testa-
ment Contained in two Sheets of Paper and Labeled together Set my hand
and Seal The Thirtieth day of October In the year of our Lord One thousand
and Seven hundred and fifty eight?
