In the Name of God Amen this Eighth day of April in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred Fifty Eight Jonathan Bettison of Granville County in the Province of South Carolina Planter I Jonathan Bettison being in My right Senses Thankful to my Redeemer for so great a Mercy therefore calling to mind the Uncertainty of this Life and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following this first and principal I Recommend my Soul and Spirit into the hands of Almighty God that gave it nothing doubting through her Grace and for the sake of my dear Redeemer to find full pardon of all my sins and Inherit Eternal life And my Body I committ to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian and decent manner at the discretion of my wife and Executors hereafter named and as touching such Worloly Estate Wherewith I hath Pleased God to bless me with all in this Life I give and dispose in manner and form following Imprimis I Will that all my just debts is paid and Funeral charges Repaid first Item I Will that after my debts being paid that my dear and lovely wife Sarah Bettison shall have use of the third Part of my Estate during her Lifetime and at her death it shall be divided Equally amongst my Children I Give unto my said wife One Leather Bed and Furniture and to live on my Plantation during her widowhood and to take care of my loving Children to make and mend for them during her widowhood I also give and Bequeath to my said One Horse and Saddle and also two Trunks To Bequeath unto my Son Remmock Bettison one Negro Fellow named Toby, Twill and Bequeath unto my Son Remmock Bettison and also my Two Daughters Sarah and Hannah Bettison All the rest of my Estate to be Equally divided among them when they come of age or Marries In such that they be maintained out of my Estate according to the discretion of my Executors I Will that they shall Sufficient Learning when my Son comes to the Age of Sixteen Years old he shall be bound out an Apprentice Twill and Give power to my Trusty Friends and Executors to Purchase one Tract of land for the use of my Estate and the Titles to be made to my son Remmock Bettison which I give to him and his Heirs for ever I give to my wife one Suit of Mourning and I do also Impower my Executors to sell that part of my Estate they think proper to discharge my Debts and to buy bargains to their discretion for the use of my Estate Lastly I do hereby mantain and Appoint my trusty friends Daniel Heyward Sarah Bettison John Heyward and Josiah Pendarvis Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereby disannulling and Making void all other Wills and Writings before me heretofore made and Requested Ratifying declaring and allowing this and Other to be and abide as my Last Will and Testament I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the day and year above written signed Sealed Published pronounced and declared by the said Jonathan Bettison as his Last Will and Testament In presence of us witnesses this eighth day of April anno Domini One thousand seven hundred fifty eight Joseph Sealey Isaac <sup>his</sup> Westbury Charles Farnall <sup>mark</sup>
