sick & weak in body but of sound & disposing Mind Memory & understanding
balling to mind the uncertainty of this life domake & declare this my Last Will &
Testament in manner & form following (that is today) First & Principal I command
my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it hoping thro the Merit & Medi-
cation of my blessed Saviour & Redeemer to obtain everlasting life my body I
commit to the Earth to be decently Interred at the discretion of my executors
herein after named And for such worldly Estate where with it hath pleased Al-
mighty God to bless me I give & dispose hereof as followeth Imprecies it is
my will & desire that all my just Debts & funerall Expences shall be well &
truly paid & satisfied by my Executors herein after named in a convenient
time as may after my decease happen It is my will & desire that my executors
herein after named & the survivor of them and the coexecutors or admors
of such survivor Do in a convenient time as may be after my decease sell
all & singular my real & personal Estate of what nature or kind soever
& the monies arising from the sale thereof (after payment & satisfaction
of all my just & lawfull debts and funeral expences) I give & bequeath
unto my two daughters Mary & Martha White who now reside in Chester
County in Pennsylvania to be paid to them share & share alike by my
doctors & admors of such survivor when they shall respectively arrive
to the age of sixteen years or day of marriage which shall first happen
& until my said two daughters do arrive & attain to their respective ages
aforesaid or day of marriage It is my will & desire that my executors here-
in after and the survivor of them & the coexecutors & admors of such survi-
vor do place out at interest the said monies arising from the sale of my said
estate & pay over a half part of the said interest money as well as principle
to each of my said two children Mary & Martha as they shall
respectively arrive or attain their respective ages of sixteen years or day
of marriage which shall first happen And whereas I have sometime
past given an authority to my friend Mr Archibald Willock of the Island
of Jamaica merchant to sell & dispose of a certain lot of land & negroes
as thereon standing & being situate lying & being in West street in Kingston
in Jamaica which very probably may be sold and disposed of by this time
if so I order & direct & it is my will & desire that my executors herein
after named & the survivor of them & the coexecutors & admors of such survi-
vor shall the said monies out of the said Archibald Willock hands or out of the
hands of the heirs of the executors or admors of the said Archibald Willock
if he should decease and when the monies arising from the sale of the said
lot & negroes if sold shall be received by my executors herein after named or
the survivor of them & the coexecutors & admors of such survivor from the
said Archibald Willock or his executors or admors I desire may be applied
as herein before mentioned & expressed that is to say One half Part
thereof to my daughter Mary & the other half part to my daughter Martha

I appoint my loving Brother David White of Chester County New London Town
Ship in the Province of Pennsylvania my friend Mr Paul Townsend of this Town
Merchant Executors of this my Last will & Testament hereby revoking
making null & void all Manner of former and Other Will or Wills by me at
any time heretofore made Ratifying Confirming & declaring This & this
Only to be & contain my last will & Testament Witness whereof The
said Joseph White have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourth day of
May in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & fifty eight

be my last will & Testament in manner following First I commend my soul

touching the worldly interest it has pleased God to bless me with I give
and Devise in following Manner I give & bequeath unto Margaret Summers
& Ann Summers (daughters of Mr James Summers late of this Province) all
all my Estate of whatsoever Nature it consists of (after my Funeral Chars
and just Debts are paid) to be Equally divided among them share & share
alike to be for them & their Heirs for ever & to be paid to them as they
respectively obtain their age of twenty one years or day of marriage if in
case either of them shall die in their minority or before marriage then the
survivor shall inherit the whole of my Estate to her & heirs for ever if both
should die before they have attained to inherit my said Estate then my Will is
that it descend unto Thomas Hazell Elizabeth Hazell & Margaret Hazell
children of Thomas Hazell Esq late of this Province deceased to them the
heirs for ever to be Equally divided between them share & share alike & so
I do nominate & appoint Paul Trapier of George Town to be Sole Executor
of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking & making null & void
all other & former Wills by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my my hand & seal on this 1st Day of April in the Year of our
Lord One thousand Seven hundred & fifty eight
