containing Two hundred Acres a Negroe man called London to him and his heirs for ever
Item I give and Bequeath unto my daughter Margaret Brown a Negroe woman
called Belia and a Boy called Jack and their increase to her and her heirs for ever
Item I give and Bequeath unto my son William Brown a Negroe Boy called Purity a
girl called Clarinda and half of the Tract of Land now live on which is Two hundred
and Ninety Acres at the West End of the Tract to him and his heirs for ever. Item I give
and Bequeath to my daughter Sarah Brown a Negroe girl called Phillis to her & her
heirs for ever. Item I give and Bequeath to my Son George Brown a Negroe man called
Jupiter and a Boy called Cygnus and the East part of the Tract now live on which
is half of the Tract I give to my son William to him and his heirs for ever. Item I
give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Ann Ambert a shilling Sterling
Item I give and Bequeath to my Son Francis & Mary & Wm & Sarah George &
Judith all my horses and Mares, and Black cattle to be Equally divided between
the above named Six Children. Item I make and constitute and appoint my
dearly beloved wife Mary Brown my Executrix for the two youngest Children
George and Judith for this my last will and Testament. Item I do hereby Nominate
Ordain appoint my Son Francis and James Querry Executors of this my last Will
and Testament, and do hereby utterly disallow, Revoke and Disannull all & every
other Former Testament, Wills, Legacies, Bequests, and Exors by me in any way
before this time made, willed and Bequeathed ratifying and confirming this
and no other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have

Funerall Expences be duly paid and satisfied, Item I will that all my

Goods and Chattels to be sold as soon as conveniently may be after my Decease and the proceeds thereof together with all my ready money, Bonds, Notes, Bills, Book debts and all my other Effects be Divided into four Equal parts or Divisions, one fourth part whereof I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Jane Morand of Charles Town for her sole separate use & Behoof one other fourth whereof I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna Fox wife of Fox of old Soho Westminster Carpenter or to her Legal Representatives, and other fourth part whereof I give and Bequeath unto my son Elias Coffey of London Watch Maker his Exors or Admors, and the remaining fourth part I give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Poyas wife of James Poyas of Charles Town Merchant and in case my Daughter Jane Morand should happen to die before the Division of my Estate is made as aforesaid I give and Bequeath the said one fourth part intended for her to the said Susanna Fox, Elias Coffey, and Elizabeth Poyas to be Equally divided between them share and share alike, and I do hereby nominate and appoint Mr. William Danbury and Mr. John Remington Exors of this my last will and Testament, and I do hereby revoke and Annul all former will and wills by me at any time heretofore made Declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament.
