this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following hereby
I revoke all former and other Wills by me heretofore made In primis I
desire that my funeral charges and all my Just debts be paid & satisfied
by my Executors hereinafter Named Item I give and devise the house & Lot
now in situate in Kings Street which I hold by lease from the
Trustees of the French Church unto my son Joseph his heirs & assigns
for his and their use and benefit for and during the term of the said lease in
Subject however to the conditions herein after mentioned Item I give
and devise unto my said son Joseph his heirs and assigns forever
One Negro Woman a slave named Judy and her four children Named
Sylvester, Sam, Isaac, and Sancho together with all her future Increase as
also one Red bay palfrey one Red bay corner cupboard all my Joiners and
Carpenters Tools Six large Silver Spoons Six silver Tea Spoons and
one Looking glass And my Will further is that in case my said son Joseph
should die before he arrives to the age of Twenty One Years that then every
thing before devised him be sold by my Executors and the Money arising
by the sale be put out at Interest by my Executors on good Personal Security
The Principal and Interest whereof to be divided unto the children of my
deceased son John share and share alike in Equal Proportions as they
come of Age respectively Item I give and Devise unto my dear Wife
Esther Vanall her heirs and assigns for ever all my Household Goods and
furniture (those before by me only devised excepted) together with all such
Goods and Merchandize that shall happen to be in the shop or in my
possession at the time of my decease, as also one Negro man a slave named
Santee in recompense for and in Lieu of Dower And my Will further is
that my said dear Wife during her Widowhood and untill my said son Joseph
comes of Age and no longer remain and continue in the House I now live
with liberty to occupy all the Outhouses Yards and Gardens thereunto

belonging for her own use and benefit. Paying the ground then
 and keeping the same in good Repair and also paying the sum
 of thirty pounds current Money of this Province per annum in
 hands of my Executors for the Maintenance and Cloathing my
 Son Joseph during his Minority but if my said Wife should die
 and leave him herself and to the satisfaction of my Executors
 devise she should retain the said sum of thirty Pounds into her
 hands for so doing and also to have the Labour of the said Neg
 Slave Judy Maintaining and Cloathing her and her Children
 Paying their Taxes And lastly my Will is that all the rest & residue
 of my Estate both real and Personal be and is hereby devised to
 Son Joseph his heirs and assigns forever and in case of this death
 he comes of Age then I devise the same to the Children of my deceased
 proportioned as aforesaid And I do hereby Nominate and Appoint
 Reverend Mr Peter Talar Minister of the French Church and the
 thereof And the Minister and Elders of the said Church for the time be
 be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament Given under my
 and seal this seventeenth day of April 1755.
