tament in manner and form following I will that all my Just Debts and
funeral Charges be paid Item I give and bequeath unto my Wife Sarah Boddington
ten shillings and six pence currentcy in law of all Right and Dowers to
her and her heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto Charles Boddington
the Son of Sarah Boddington seven shillings and six pence to him and his
heirs for ever and unto the remainder of the Children of the said Sarah Bod-
dington I give and Bequeath unto each of them the sum of seven shillings
and six Pence to them and their heirs for ever Item I give and Bequeath
unto my Son George Boddington the sum of seven shillings and six pence cur-
rency Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Benjamin Boddington one
negro woman called Phebe to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and
bequeath unto my Son Joseph Boddington one negro man named Will to him
and his heirs for ever and all the remainder and Residue of my personal
Estate goods Right and credits whatsoever and wheresoever I give and be-
queath unto my well beloved friend Sarah Book widow to her and her heirs
for ever Lastly I do make and constitute the said Sarah Book widow
whole and Sole executrix of this my Last will and testament to sell and
dispose of my Intres at her discretion as she shall judge most convenient

In the name of God Amen I Ann Partridge Widow of Nathaniel Partridge
late of Charles Town Gentleman deceased do make and Ordain this my Last
Will and Testament as followeth (to wit) I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Daughter Catharine the wife of Chidemus Croft to her own separate Use and dis-
posal without the interposition of her said Husband A Negro man named Will
and three Negro Girls named Glorina Kate & Mary Item I give and bequeath
unto my said Daughter Catharina Croft and to her Executors & Admors all
the rest and residue of my Negroes and Other Slaves whatsoever Upon this Special
Trust and confidence nevertheless (that is today) upon Trust that the said
Catharina Croft her Executors & Admors do hold three of the said Slaves to wit
Patty Munda & Abram (son of Patty) for the use and behoof of my beloved Daughter
Ann Wood during the Term of her natural Life and after her Decease then my Will
is that the said last mentioned with their Issue and Increase be divided one third
to the Children of my Daughter Catharine Croft one other third to the Children
of my beloved Son Nathaniel Partridge and the remaining third to the Children
of my beloved Son William Partridge and upon this further Trust that the said
Catharina Croft her Executors and Admors do hold two other of the said slaves
namely Abram and Tommy for the proper use and behoof of the Children
of my said Son Nathaniel to be divided between them share and share alike
and upon this further Trust also that the said Catharina Croft her Executors
and Admors do hold two others of the Slaves named Pompey and Sue for the use
and behoof of the Children of my said Son William Partridge to be divided Equally

among them and upon this further trust that she the said Catharine Croft
do and other of the said Slaves named Quash for the use of my son in law W^m Den-
ington for the term of three years from the time of my decease & after the expi-
ration of the said three years then for the use & behoof of the children of my said
son William Partridge and upon this further trust that she the said Catharine
Croft do sell one other of the remaining Slaves named Florilla and with the
money thereby arising purchase a young new Negro Woman for the use of the
children of my said son Nathaniel Partridge and upon this further trust
that she the said Croft do sell and dispose of two other of the remaining Slaves
(to wit) Gabriel and Julia to defray the Expences of my Funeral Charges and
lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint the said Nathaniel Par-
tridge and William Partridge Executors of this my last Will & Testament
Notwithstanding all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore
made and declaring this only to be and contain my last Will & Testament
In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this eight day of
August One Thousand Seven Hundred and fifty eight

of South Carolina Planter being at Presents Infirm in Body but of sound minde
and memory and understanding and considering the Unsure Countie of Life as
also for the more ease and content of my wife and children after my decease do
hereby make and declare this Instrument to be and contain my last Will and
Testament Resigning my Soul to God any body to the Earth from whence it came
in hopes of a Blessed Resurrection to Eternal Life Imprimis I Give and bequeath
unto my beloved wife Elizabeth one Horse named Jockey and a two Year old
Horse named Dareck and two Cows and Calves and her saddle and all the House
hold furniture I Give and bequeath unto my Son William Stewart one Negro man
named Sabat and one Negro boy named Prince and the tract of Land and Planta-
tion that I now Live upon and four Shares out of seven of this Crop that is now
a Planting Imprimis I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary thirty
Eight Pounds and to my daughter Ann one hundred and fifty Pounds to be payed
out of my Estate before any Division be made thereof and as for the Remaining
part of my Estate I order it to be divided in seven Equal Parts amongst my wife
and children Viz my son William Stewart and my Daughters Rebeckah
and Jannet two children James Fleming and Jannet Fleming and Elizabeth
and Mary and Ann and if any of my children die without Day Hair of their own
Body their shall be an Equal Division made of their Part amongst those
of my own children that are alive and lastly I do Nominate constitute and
appoint my sons William Stewart and James Fleming and John K^r Bridge
and William Wilson and William Fleming to be my Executors of this my last
Will and Testament In Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
this Twenty third day of May in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred
and fifty Eight
