dred Pounds current Money of South Carolina And I give and bequeath unto
Nephew Peter Bonnotheau the Sum of two hundred Pounds of like Sum
Money which Legacies I Will be paid within Twelve Months next after
my decease Also I give and bequeath unto my Sister Elizabeth Banbury
as a token of my Affection One Mourning Ring And I give devise and
bequeath unto my very Affectionate & Loving Wife Charlotte Banbury
and to her heirs and assigns for ever All my Messuages Lands Tenements
and other my real Estate within the Province of South Carolina except
the Tract of Land which was given me by my Uncle Gabriel Manigault
which Tract of Land Given me by the said Mr. Manigault I give the
use only of the same to my said Wife during the Term of her Natural Life
And after her decease to my Right heirs forever to be Absolutely Possessed
Possessed and Enjoyed by them And I give and bequeath unto my said
Wife Charlotte Banbury all the rest residue and remainder of my
Personal Estate Negroes ready Money Bonds Bills Notes Books
or of what Nature or kind the same may be or where so ever the same
may be found to have and to hold the same unto my said Wife
her Executors Administrators and assigns forever And I do hereby
Nominate and Appoint my said Wife Charlotte Banbury
