one Man and the Executors shall choose one Man these three shall divide
all the Real and Personal Estate allotted them that my Son Daniel may have
his Part without selling any Part or Parts thereof until my Son John is
of Age My Will is that one third of the Produce of the Estate shall be
for my Beloved Wife and the other two thirds shall be for the Use of my
Children to Maintain Cloath and Educate them And Lastly I Nominate
