And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless

of Land joining together on the South Side of Black River whercon I now
live of Six hundred Acres And all my moveable Estate after all my debts is
paid to be kept together till my son William arrives to the Age of Twenty
one years and then to have an equal share with his Mother and the Rest of
my Lawful Children and it is my will that all my Children as they arrive
to Age may have an equal dividend of my moveable Estate divided of to them
And further it is my Will that if any of my Children should die before they
are of Age that their part may be equally divided amongst the others And
I do hereby utterly Revoke and disannull all former Wills & Legacies and
