All my Hogs and Horned Creatures as Cows, Steers Calfs and their Produce, and in fine) all Goods and Chattels which are now in my possession, and doth furthermore) by these presents, assign and desire all and every one who are to me indebted, to pay them to the said Mary Burton my Wife. And do hereby Impower the said Mary Burton to collect and use as her own, all debts wheresoever due. Which said Goods and Chattels, when it shall please God to call me out of this mortal State, I do hereby confirm Deliver and Bequeath unto the said Mary Burton my Loving Wife her Heirs, and assigns for ever, and doth fully and firmly desire, that this my Last Will and Testament may be and stand in full force and Virtue. In witness whereof I have hereunto set and put my hand and seal this 24th day of October 1753.
