Death be given and go to my daughter Sarah Russell and her heirs but
if she shall die without lawful issue that then the said Part shall go
to the children of my daughter Mary Evans lawfully begotten in
Equal Proportion also I give to my said Daughter Mary Evans &
to her children lawfully begotten a Tract of land lying and being
in Raven County aforesaid in friends Neck on the South side of Wateree
River containing two hundred acres butting and bounding on said
