Likewise my said Wife shall have the full Command and Authority of a mistress in and about my said Plantation and shall have the Ordering of House Affairs without Interruption or Molestation and shall Command a boy or Girl to attend her when ever she Pleases to go abroad, and this in Bar or Lieu of dower or thirds or any part of my Estate that she may claim by Marriage and if my said Wife should Marry again my Will is that she be paid fifty Pounds currency out of my Personal Estate and she go Immediately off from my Plantation and have no more to do nor concern with nor demands on my Estate for ever Item I give and bequeath to my son Stephen my Plantation with all the buildings thereon to him his heirs and assigns for ever And he may Dispose of the same with the Rest of my Children immediately after my decease notwithstanding that if he be single or leave a Wife without issue or issue by him begotten before the time above mentioned of my Wife & daughter being either dead or Married and my Son James Arriving at the age of twenty one years my Will then is that my Plantation go to the heirs or heirs in Law of my Family and I give devise & bequeath the same to him her or them and to his her or their heirs and assigns forever After the death or Marriage of my Wife I Will that my Personal Estate be equally divided amongst my three Sons Stephen Joseph and James and my four daughters Ann Mary Sarah and Christian and to the issue devise and bequeath the same to them and their heirs forever Each shall Receive their part as they may or come to the age of twenty one years And lastly I do hereby appoint my two Loving Sons Stephen and Joseph Fogartie likewise my Loving Brother in Law Stephen Miller and my loving brother David Fogartie to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking & making void all former Wills by me heretofore made and this only to Contain all that I have said in my last will and Testament sealed Published and declared by the said Stephen Fogartie to be his last Will and Testament in presence of the said David Singeltary, David Singeltary, John Sanders.
