God to bless me with in this life Give and dispose of the same in the manner  
and form following, Imprimis, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife  
Susannah Oldfield one third part of my personal Estate that is to say Negroes  
horses Cattle and all other moveable & and a horse and Saddle and to live  
upon the Plantation if she thinks proper during her widowhood Item I give  
and bequeath unto my son Francis Oldfield the remaining two thirds of my  
of my personal Estate together with the Tract of Land I now live upon to him  
and the Heirs of his body for ever And in case my son Francis Oldfield should  
die before he attains to the age of Twenty one years then one half of the  
Personal Estate I left him to go to his mother Susannah Oldfield And the other  
half of the Personal Estate to be Equally divided between Sam<sup>r</sup>. Sleigh Jun<sup>r</sup>  
and Hugh Sleight and the land above mentioned to go to Sam<sup>r</sup>. Sleigh Jun<sup>r</sup>  
to him and the Heirs of his body for ever I do constitute and appoint my belov-  
ed wife Susannah Oldfield and Sam<sup>r</sup>. Sleigh & Hugh Sleight my Executors and  
Executors of this my Last Will and Testament Ratifying and Confirming this  
and no other to be my Last Will and Testament Revoking and disannulling  
all and every other will and Testaments
