In the Name of God Amen Elizabeth Timothy of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina Widow being weak in Body but of Sound Mind and memory do this Second day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty Seven make and Publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say I give and bequeath my Soul to God the Almighty giver and my Body to be buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named And as to what Worldly Goods I am at the time of my decease Possessor of, I give bequeath and devise the same as follows First I give and bequeath to my Son Peter all my Books of Account whatsoever, together with a certain Bond due to me from John Hammetton to have and enjoy as his own Property all and whatsoever may be due upon the said Books and Bond to himself and his heirs forever, the said Books and Bond now being in his Possession. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary Elizabeth now the Widow of Abraham Bourquin deceased all that Southernmost Tenement of my House in King Street which Joins on Land now belonging to my Son Peter together with so much of my Lot of Land as is Situate to the Westward of the said Tenement that is to say of the Width of the said Tenement and the full depth of my said Lot I do likewise give and bequeath to my said daughter Mary Elizabeth two Negro Women Slaves named Molly and Flora to her and her heirs for ever And also one half of my household Furniture and wearing Apparel together with one half of whatever Money may be in the house at my decease. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Catherine now the Wife of Theodore Frezevent my Negro Slaves Dianah with her two Children Dollan and Hagar to her and her heirs for ever. Item I do will and require that the Northmost Tenement of my house adjoining Mrs Jane Malveys with the Land back thereof not yet bequeathed be sold or divided as my Executors shall agree within Twelve Months after my decease one half of the Proceeds of which Sale I give and bequeath to my daughter Catherine aforesaid and her heirs and the other half of the Proceeds of such Sale together with my Negro Slaves Named Abraham, Amsterdam and Judith with the other half of my Household furniture not yet devised and bequeathed and of the Money that may remain after my decease I do hereby give and bequeath unto my daughter Louisa now the Wife of James Richards and the heirs of her Body lawfully begotten and to her and their own use and to no other Use Intent or Purpose whatsoever Item I do likewise give & bequeath unto my Son Peter for my Grandson a Silver Watch which did belong to my late husband Lewis Timothy to be delivered to my said Son Peter immediately after my decease And I do constitute Ordain and Appoint my loving daughter Mary Elizabeth Bourquin and my loving Son in Law Theodore Frezevent Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking and making Void

her calf. Item I give unto Thomas Bennet my Gun. Item I give unto Robert
Gibbons my Musket. Item I give to Edward Hazzelwood my Horse named
Hazzard Item I give unto Morris Fleming my black horse called Martin &
my large China Punch Bowl. Item I give unto Eliz^a Parroch now the Widow
of one son or Maccan of Liverpool in England during her Natural Life
my Negro Wench called Flora but after the decease of the said Parroch alias
son or Maccan then the said Negro Wench to be Manumitted and set free
neither is the said Flora liable to be sold on any account of any Debt or
demand whatsoever Item I give unto Doctor Soinel Chalmers for services
done me my Diamond Ring upon condition that he is satisfied therewith
from any further demands against my Estate. Item I give unto Elizabeth
Tookerman my Silver Tea spoons China cups and saucers Item I give to
John Methingham Jun^r my black Barrow Hogg. Item I give unto Richard
Fowler my Silver shoe buckles and breeches Buckles. Item I give unto John
Fowler my Saced hatt Wiggs and gold sleeve Buttons, And as Rich Tookerman
is Indebted unto me for Lands he Purchased of me, I direct that the said
Tookerman do pay unto Benjamin Smith Merchant in Charles Town for a
Debt due by one to the said Smith the sum of two hundred Pounds Currency
more or less and unto Morris Fleming the sum of one hundred Pounds like
Money more or less for a Debt due by me to him and that he procure from them as
an Interest discharge which he is to deliver unto my Executor then and in
such case thereby forever quit and discharge the said Tookerman from all
