of the Ancestors of the ~~Shirburn~~ & Montgomerys Estates
And the Remainder of the Money due upon the Mortgage of
M^r. Thos. Edwards's Estate at Landover, I do may send to my
Brother Bagot Read Esq^r in Chester. And also for my part of
the Note of hand of the Tenant at Maxmawr in Montgomery
for the Stock of Peop^l who I hope will on my Account settle
all affairs for you. As to what I have in this Province
may be found where due in my Books. In regard to
Georgia there is a Deed of Gift Left in the Hands of
Otho Lango Esq^r at Savannah from Joseph Waton to me
for Lands in that Province. Witness my hand and Seal at
Town aforesaid the fourth day of July 1757.
