In the Name of God Amen I John Singer being sick, weak of body but imperfect mind and memory do make this my Last Will and Testament in the manner and form as followeth; First I recommend my soul unto the hands of almighty God hoping to have full pardon and forgiveness of all my temporal goods and estate as it hath pleased God to take from me with I give and bequeath as follows First my will is that all my just debts and funeral charges shall be paid and discharged Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved mother Hannah Singer the use of my five Negroe's and their issue viz Tom Diana July Abram Thomas and all my Stock of Cattell & Horses during her natural life of and after her decease to be equally Divided between my Brother Joseph Singer and my Nephew Anthony Bonneau Lastly Nominate and Appoint my Brother in law William Bonneau and my Sister Mary Bonneau my Executord and by witness to this my Last Will and Testament I hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of September and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty eight.

In the Name of God Amen the Thirtieth day of January One thousand Seven hundred and fifty five I William Welby of John Island Planter being in perfect health & sound in Mind and Memory Thanks be given to God for the same therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing it is Appointed for all men once to die I make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament that is to say I give and bequeath unto my soul unto the hands of God that gave it and for my body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian like and Decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of God and touching such Worldly Estate wherewith I have Deived God to bless me with in this Life I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form As I purpose it is my Will and I do Order that in the first place that all my just debts and funeral charges be fully paid and satisfied Item it is my Will and pleasure that my beloved Daughter Martha Welby shall have the use of that part of my Estate both real and personal as I shall hereafter Nominate during her natural life and after my decease to the lawfull Heirs of her Body But in case she dies without heir then it shall return to the lawfull heirs of my Daughter Mary Stocks Body that is to say that my Daughter Martha Welby shall have the use of my Plantation where now lies containing three hundred forty two acres of Land Likewise a Negro Woman named Hannah or Gile called Phoebe one boy Sam one Ditto Anthony one Ditto Little & Tom Old Hector Cooper Tom Jenny old adam Little Phillips and her Child Till and her Child Isaac Old Phillips to live on the Plantation but not to be put to any hard Labour nor to be misused and to find in clothes and Provision Item it is my Will and pleasure that my beloved Daughter Mary Stocks shall have the use of that Part of my Estate both Real and Personal as I shall hereafter Nominate during her natural life and after her decease to the lawfull heirs of her Body But in case she dies without heir then it shall return to the lawfull heirs of my Daughter Martha Welbys Body that is to say that my Daughter Mary Stocks shall have the use of that Tract of Land on Soobooda containing four hundred acres of Land Likewise one Negro woman called Sarah one Girl Ditta Linda one boy Peter one Ditta London Little Abraham Jacob Joe Big London and her Child Big Abraham Wally Little adam James & Venus And further it is my Will that my household Furniture Plantation Tools and my Stock of Cattle Horses Sheep & Hogs and all other Utencils be Equally Divided between my Daughters Martha Welby & Mary Stocks and Further that if my daugthers disagree about what I have done in dividing my Estate that the Transgressor shall loose the whole of their Part of my Estate both Real and Personal and the other shall have the use of the whole Estate I likewise Nominate Appoint Ordain & constitute Mr John Free Senior Mr Thomas Fleming Mr John Holmes Mr Thomas Gounscomb to be my Executors to this my Last Will and Testament

Be it Remembered That I John Witter of Berkley County in the Province
of South Carolina (Planter) being ungood health of Body & of Sound Disposing
Mind and Memory & Understanding (Devised belied for the same) Do make &
Ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner & Form following That is to say
First I will and order That all my just debts & Funeral charges be duly paid &
Satisfied (by my Executors hereafter named) Out of the Estates I may have bring
tome at the time of my decease or out of the Produce of my Plantations Before any
Division of my Estate be made to my Legatees hereafter mentioned Item I give
and bequeath unto my Grandson John Witter his Negro Slaves Viz Cudjo
Phillip Grace Mary & her Two Children I likewise give and bequeath unto my
Grandson John Witter (When as he attains the age of Twenty One years) One hundred
& forty acres of Land Part with the Houses thereon his Late Father lived by Part of
the tract I bought of James Screeves to hold to him his Heirs & Assigns for ever In
my Will further is That my Daughter in Law Hannah Parrott do continue in the
said House & Plantation till my said Grandson John Witter attains the age of
Eighteen Years (if she shall live so long) Keeping the House & out houses in Repair
Except my Executors see just cause to the contrary And my said Daughter in Law
Hannah Parrott shall render every year at Just Account unto my Executors
of all the Crops & produce that shall be made with the Negroes in her Possession
one Third Part thereof belongs to herself and the other two Thirds Parts to my said
Grandson (John Witter) and after (Deducting the charges of maintaining Cloathing
& Education) my said Grandson who shall pay the Remainder of the Money
arising from the said Two third Parts to my Executors to be by them put out at In
terest for the Benefit of my said Grand Son and if my said Grandson should die
before he attains the age of Twenty One years or have lawfull issue of his Body
Then the Share and Part of my Estate both real & personal hereby intended
for my said Grandson shall go to Descend & be Equally Divided among such of
my children as shall then be living Share & Share alike Item I give and
bequeath unto my four Grand Children William Bee Joseph Bee Mary
& Elizabeth Bee the Seven following Negroes Slaves That is to say Cyrus
Jenny Flora and her Two Children Betty & her Child to be Equally Divided be
tween them by my Executors the Boys when they shall respectively attain the
age of Twenty One years and the Girls at the age of Eighteen years or day of
Marriage and if any of them should die before they arrive at the said Ages To
be Equally Divided amongst the survivors of them Item I likewise give and
bequeath to my two Grand Sons William Bee & Joseph Bee and to the sum
of them that tract of Land that formerly was Benjamin Witters as far as
the Eastermost Side of the Path leading to the Savannah containing One hun
dred & thirty Acres (Or therabouts) To them and their Heirs for ever to be equal
ly Divided between them by my Executors when they shall respectively attain
the age of Twenty One years But and if both of my said Grandsons should die
without lawfull issue than the said Land shall Devolve and go to the three
sons or the survivor or survivor of them Share & share alike And my Will fur
ther is that my son in Law William Bee shall have the use and Possession
of the said Plantation above given to my two Grandsons till the death of them
then
