 planter being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind & memory
 Thanks be given unto God for the same, therefore calling unto mind
 the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all
 men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
 That is to say principally and at first of all I give and recommend my
 Soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend
 to the earth to be buried in decent christian burial at the discretion
 of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I
 shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching
 such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in
 this life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and
 form - First I give and bequeath unto Christins my dearly beloved wife &
 my three children as Catharina and Margit and George the tract of land
 I now live on containing One hundred acres with all buildings and improvements
 thereon. Also I give to my said Wife and the said three children
 one Negro woman named Moley and a negro boy named Dublin - Two working
 horses one named Bup & the other named Relak. One plantation plow together
 with all beds & Cloaths and household furniture to have and to hold to my s^d wife
 and the above s^d children and to their heirs and assigns forever.
 Also I give to my son (William and daughter Magdalena) Henry and my
 son Jacob a negro girl named Sarey. To have and to hold to my said sons and
 Henry and Jacob and to their heirs and assigns forever. Also I give to my son
 William and daughter Magdalena a Negro girl named Peggy to have and
 to hold to my said son William & daughter Magdalena and to their heirs
 and assigns forever. Also I give to my son Anthony and to his heirs & assigns
 forever Two hundred Acres of Land lying in the forks of Broad River & Schuyl
 to have and to hold to my said son Anthony and to their heirs & assigns forever.
 Also I give to my said son Anthony & my daughter Elizabeth a Negro
 girl named Hannah, to have & to hold to my said son & daughter Elizabeth
 & their heirs - And the rest of my Estate as Horses, ^{hairs} Neg^s Cattle, Wagon
 & other plantation tools I desire & will that it be ^{equally} divided ^{between all my abovesaid} equal share & portion
 alike. Also I constitute make & ordain my loving son William my sole Executor
 to this my last Will and Testament & I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & dis-
 annul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies & Requests & Executors
 by me in any ways before named Milled & bequeathed ratifying & confirming
 this & no other to be my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my Hand & Seal the day & year first above written
 Signed sealed, published, pronounced & declared
 by the said Anthony Steek as his last Will &
 Testament in the presence of us the Subscribers
