I give & bequeath to my well beloved daughter Rachel Weeks One negro girl named Nancy - And all the Residue of my estate both Real & personal I give & bequeath to my beloved son Job Wright by him to be freely possessed & enjoyed and I do hereby constitute make and ordain Samuel Nely & Samuel Millhouse the sole Executors of this my last will and Testaments. And I do utterly disallow revoke and Disannul all & every other former Testaments Wills legacies bequeaths & Executors by me in any ways before named Willed & bequeathed Ratifying & Confirming this to be my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & fifty nine in the thirty second year of his Majesty's Reign
