I Elix^a Williamson of the Province of South Carolina do make & Declare this my last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say first I Bequeath my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God hoping a remission of my Sins by the merits of Jesus Christ of Jesus Christ & my Body I Commit to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of my Exors hereafter Named & my Worldly Estate I give & Devise as follows my Will is that my Executors do Sell all my Lands & the moneys arising therefrom to be deemed as part of my Personal Estate.

Item I Give to the Meeting known by the Name of General Baptists the sum of two Hundred pounds Current money of the Province aforesaid to be paid at the Expiration of one Year after my decease also my Will is that my Expiration Executors do Sell Ishmael, Jan Hannah & Jacob. Item I Give unto my Loving Son Champemoun the following Negroes Daphney, plate, Sarah & Little Ishmael & also my household Goods to him & his heirs forever. Item I Give unto my Loving Son Bony the following Negroes, Scipio, Muley, Kinah, Tills & Budje to him & his heirs forever. Item I Give all the Rest & Residue of my Estate to my two Sons Champemoun & Bony Williamson to be Equally Divided Between them Share & Share alike at & age of Twenty one Years but in case Either should die without lawful Issue the Survivor to be his heir & in case Both should die without lawful Issue then in such case I Give to Mr. Arthmas Elliotts Daughter Elizabeth Elliott the sum of One Thousand pound Current of the Province aforesaid to her & her heirs forever. All the rest & residue of my Estate I Give to my Loving Cousin Benjamin Elliott to him & his heirs forever. I do hereby Constitute & appoint my Loving Cousins Benj^a & Saml Elliotts Executors of this my last Will & Testament thereby revoking all former & other Wills by me at any time heretofore made in Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this Eighteenth day of August one Thousand Seven Hundred & Sixty.
