Elezia Williamson of the province of South Carolina do make & Declare this my last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say first I Bequeath my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God hoping a remission of my Sins by the merits of Jesus Christ of Jesus Christ & my Body I Commit to the Earth to be buried at the Discretion of my executors hereafter named of my worldly Estate I give & Devise as follows my Will is that my Executors do Sell all my Lands & the moneys arising therefrom to be deemed as part of my personal Estate.

**Item** I Give to the Meeting known by the Name of General Baptists the sum of two hundred pounds Current money of the Province aforesaid to be paid at the Expiration of one Year after my decease also my Will is that my Expiration Executors Do sell Privately from Hannah & Jacob. **Item** I Give unto my living Son Chappernoun the following Negroes Daphney, Plato, Sarah & Kittey Skinner & also my household Goods to him & his heirs forever. **Item** I Give unto my living Son Benja the following Negroes Scipio, Mulky, Rinah, Tels & Cudjo to him & his heirs forever. **Item** I Give all the Rest & Residue of my Estate to my two Sons Chappernoun & Benja Williamson to be Equally Divided Between them Share & Share alike at the age of Majority one year but in case either should die without Lawful Issue the Survivor to be his heir & in Case Death Should die without Lawful Issue then in such Case I Give to Mr. Artimus Elliott's Daughter Elizabeth Elliott the sum of One Thousand pounds Current of my Province aforesaid to her & her heirs forever All the rest & residue of my Estate I Give to my living Cousin Benjamin Elliott to him this heirs forever. I do hereby constitute & appoint my living Cousins Benj & Saml Elliotts Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking all former other Wills by me at any time heretofore made in Witness Whereof I have setunto Set my hand & Seal this Eighteenth day of August one Thousand Seven Hundred & Sixty.
