In The Name of God, Amen; I George Starrat being sick and weak of Body but of sound and perfect memory, do make & ordain this my last Will and Testament, first & principally I commend my Soul to almighty God who gave it me, who by the merits of Jesus Christ, I hope to obtain a full and free Pardon of all my Sins, and to stand upon the Earth at the last day I commit my Body to the Earth, to be decently interred without pomp or ostentation in a Black Coffin in my own plantation, at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter mentioned, and as to such worldly Estate, as it hath pleased God to bestow on me, I give and Bequeath in the manner following; First I order my Plantation to be sold and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between my Nephews Archibald, Thomas and George Starrat, and in case any or either of them should die without Lawful Issue, then their share to be equally divided amongst their Sisters and Cousins in the Kingdom of Ireland, Then as soon as my Plantation is sold & the Croft on the Ground, or whatsoever situation it is in is taken of, Then I desire my Negroes to be sold in the manner & form following vizt. I give and Bequeath to my Nephew Arch. Starrat Pompey, Mary Anthony, Quash

Abram & Susy to him his heirs & assigns for ever with their issue provided  
 begins Dorinda a winter suit of Clothes every year rifice of want.  
 I give and bequeath to my nephew James Starrat In the Kingdom of  
 Ireland Twelv Negro Slaves vizt: Simon, Windsor, Newark, Sam Gillis  
 Jamey, Prince Primus, Master Delia, with her children Peter & Charles  
 with their issue to be sold & the money remitted to him, I give and  
 bequeath to my nephew Thomas George Starrat the rest Slaves  
 following vizt: Cato Hagar Judy, Scipio Eabo Kate, Cain, Maria Rachell  
 Pecke, Elmos, Bello & her child Jo, Black Frank, Anna their children  
 Pera Yamma Pegg, Pegg Little, Kate Little, Cora Sarah, Nrich Steffney to  
 Lett & patty Paul Cannah, Bally, Little Frank, Duckan Anna Pegg,  
 Gambia, Phoebe red Lucy nanny Sandy, which are to be sold & the  
 monies arising therefrom to be equally divided between them & to be  
 made in due payments the first to be made as soon as money can be  
 collected from the Sales of the above Slaves. I likewise desire that  
 a young Negroe girl be purchased & given to David Brinman's eldest  
 Child, and if my present Credit should fail of Discharging my  
 Debts and expenses, Then Doct<sup>r</sup> Alex<sup>r</sup> McDowell & David Brinman  
 must be first upon for what money the one, and every thing to continue  
 in the same situation until the Slaves is sold and I constitute and  
 appoint Paul Trapier Esq<sup>r</sup> Mr. Joseph Alston & Archibald Starrat  
 Executors of this my last Will & Testament.
