In the Name of God amen The Thirtieth Day of October in the
year of our lord one Thousand seven hundred and sixty I the aforesaid Parrot
of James Island in Berkeley County widow being sick & weak in body but thanks
be to God of sound mind and judgment do make & ordain this my present last
Will and Testament in manner & form following That is to say first and
principally I commend my soul into the hands of almighty God hoping through
the merits Death & passion of my saviour Jesus Christ to have full & free
pardon and forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit everlasting life and
my body I commit to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter named and as touching the disposition of all such temporal estate
as in God hath pleased to bestow upon me I give and dispose thereof as
followeth First my will is that all my just debts and funeral charges
be first satisfied and paid Item I give unto my loving son Thomas Collins
the sum of five pounds Current money of South Carolina it being his full
part and share of my whole Estate both real & personal Item I give unto
my loving daughter in law Patience Collins all my wearing apparel
Capturing it be my Buckles Buttons & Rings Item I give and bequeath unto
my loving Grandson Jonah Collins and to the lawful issue of his body a small
tract of land joining the Presbyterian meeting house land which contains five
acres and three quarters more or less But if my grandson Jonah Collins
should die without lawful issue of his body I then give the said five acres &
three quarters of land more or less unto my loving grandson John Collins & him
and his heirs forever Item I give & bequeath unto my loving grandson
Jonah Collins One feather bed bolster pillow & blanket together with one
Gold Ring with the following Poey when this you see remember me and
also my silver shoe buckles to him and his heirs forever Item It is
likewise my will and desire further that the part of my deceased husband
Benjamin Parrot's estate which I am entitled to shall be demanded by my
Exr & at the death of Mrs Ann Parrot mother to my deceased husband Benjamin
Parrot and the said part or share to be equally divided by my Exr between
my loving son John Mitten & my two grandsons Jonah & John Collins & them &

and their heirs forever. Item I leave unto my loving son John Mitten during his natural life the use of all the rest and remaining part of my estate whatsoever but wher it shall please God that my loving son John Mitten departs this life I then give the said Remaining part to the lawful issue of his body if there should be any then living but if there should be no issue of his body then living it is then my will and desire that my Executors shall sell the said remaining part at publick vendue and the money to be equally divided between my two grandsons Jonah & John Collins, but if either of my two grandsons shall die before they arrive to the age of twenty one years then I give their part to the survivor And Lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my loving uncle Henry Samways Sen^r and my truey friend George Rivers Sen^r execs of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow Riske & Dwarne all other former wills and Testaments Requeries & Requests, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written Signed sealed published & declared by the said Hannah Parrot as her last Will & Testament in the presence of us Wm Holmes
