 unto my Sons John Henry & William Lewis after all my
 funeral Charges & Lawful Debts be truly Discharged. Item I
 give & bequeath to my Beloved Sons John Henry & W^m Lewis all
 my Estate Real & Personal to be equally to be shared among them
 Item my will & Desire is that my Son W^m should be my sole
 Executor in this my last Will & Testament, allowing this & no
 other to be my last Will & Testament in Witness whereof I have
 runte set my hand & seal this Twenty third day of December & in the year of our
 Lord one Thousand seven hundred & sixty
