 and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs which I have strength and  
 Capacity so to do I make & publish this my last Will and Testament And  
 first & Principally I commit my soul into the hands of my Creator who gave  
 it and my body to the Earth to be interred at the discretion of my Sons hereafter  
 named and as to such worldly estate wherewith I hath pleased God to furnish  
 me I Dispose of the same as followeth that is to say wherewith I will that  
 all my just debts & several Expenses be paid and Discharged  
 I do give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Ursula Jeanneret her  
 Heirs & Assigns forever all that my tract of land containing three hundred  
 and seven acres situate on the Head of King Mary Watling & bounding to  
 the South on River May & West on John Henry de Roche to the north  
 on Michael Sealy to the East on Capt<sup>m</sup> Pascher Land I do give and  
 bequeath likewise unto my said wife Ursula all that my one other tract of land  
 containing seven hundred acres situate in the Township of Curiborough on the South  
 Swamp Watling & bounding to the north on Cac<sup>l</sup> lands to the East on Cac<sup>l</sup> lands

to the south on River conveyed by me to Daniel Hayward Esq<sup>r</sup> to the West part on  
 Michael Rorer & part on Henry Chiffelle. I do give and bequeath likewise unto  
 my said wife Ursula all that my one other tract of land containing <sup>two hundred</sup> fifty acres  
 situate in the Township of Curiborough on Saranach River Watling & bounding  
 to the West on Saranach River to the north on Cac<sup>l</sup> land to the East on John Henry  
 de Roche to the south on Crowborough Land I do give and bequeath likewise  
 unto my said wife Ursula all that my Town Lot situate in the Township of Richiborough  
 11<sup>th</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> Watling and bounding to the north on David Saupys Lott to the W<sup>est</sup> on the  
 Bay to the South on a Street & to the East on General Peffer I do give and  
 bequeath unto my said wife Ursula her Heirs & Assigns forever  
 all and singular my negroes horses mares Cattle & stock with their future  
 Issue and Increase & all and singular my household goods furniture and other my  
 personal Estate of what nature or kind soever. I do give unto my sister  
 Mary twenty shillings Current money of the Province appraised I do give  
 unto my other sister Rose Mary twenty shillings Current money of the Province  
 appraised I do give and devise unto my two Nephews Henry and David Jeanneret  
 Sons of my Brother Abram Jeanneret the sum of five pound Current money of the  
 Province appraised Each And lastly I do hereby nominate constitute &  
 appoint my said beloved wife Ursula the sole Executrix of this my last Will  
 & Testament And I do hereby revoke and make void all former & other Will  
 and Testament by me at any time or times hereafter made and I do declare this  
 only to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I Henry Jeanneret  
 the Testator have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal the  
 twenty eighth day of September in the third year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord  
 George the third by the Grace of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King  
 Defender of the Faith & so forth and in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand  
 seven hundred & sixty three
