First I bequeath my soul to God that gave it me and my body I give to the earth from whence it came to be buried in a Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named. Inprimis I bequeath and give to my loving wife Ruth all and singular household furniture her riding horse and saddle two best work horses six cows and calves and the privilege of killing the stock any she thinks necessary before the division. Excepting two beds and their furniture I also give her all my negroes Slaves and my home stead place during her natural life or day of widowhood I give and bequeath to Jacob Brown one negro girl called Nancy after the decease of my wife I also give and bequeath to William Gordon one negro Boy called Bobb I also give and bequeath to Dorcas Gordon and George Gordon jointly and severally one negro woman called Chloe I also give and bequeath my dwelling plantation to be equally divided between my four youngest sons that is to say Abraham Henry Henry and Jacob my son Jacob to have my homestead place after my wife's decease my will and desire is that the residue of my Estate lands and Chattels be divided so that all my children and my wife's children have and equal part of it. Only William Gordon Jacob Brown Dorcas Gordon and George Gordon to have one half part with the rest in consideration of their legacies mentioned before. Item I give and bequeath my son Joshua my large bible and it is not to be valued with the rest I appoint my son Thomas Gordon and my Abell Anderson to be the Executors of this my last will and Testament afterly disavowing all former wills Ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my

my Seal this 11th of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty Three.

In the Name of God amen I Jacob Naight of John's Island in the Province of South Carolina being sick & weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory (Blessed be God) therefore do this twenty seventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty four and in the fifth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord King George The Third make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say Inprimis I commend my soul into the hands of almighty God who gave it me and my body to the earth from whence it came in sure and certain hopes of a joyful resurrection through the merits of my Lord and saviour Jesus Christ and as for that worldly Estate which it hath pleased God to enrich me with I dispose thereof as followeth (that is to say) First I will that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid by my Executors hereafter named as soon as conveniently can be after my decease. Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Brother William Naight and to the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten all that my plantation or tract of land of land situate and being on St. Helena Island in Charlevoix county in the Province aforesaid and in case of his death without such issue then my will is that my said plantation or tract of land on St. Helena Island aforesaid shall descend unto and become vested in my next heir male of the name of Naight and to the heirs of such stock. Item I give unto my Brother William Naight and to the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten all those my five negroes named Peter Carolina Henry May and one Old woman named Legg and in case of my said Brother's death without issue males then I give the said five negroes unto my next heir male of the name of Naight. Item I give and devise unto my nephew Abraham Naight the son of my Brother Abraham Naight and to his heirs and assigns all that my plantation or tract of land where I now live situate lying and being on John's Island in Colleton County in the Province of S^c Carolina. Item I give to my Brother Abraham Naight my new boat together with all and singular the sails and rigging to the same belonging. Item I give to my sister Mary

Mary Godfrey the wife of Robert Godfrey during the term of her natural life The site of one half of the dwelling house situated on a plantation on Johns Island commonly called or known by the name of Backs Row and my will further is that my Executors hereafter named and the survivors and survivor of them do permit and suffer my said sister Mary Godfrey to have present and clear of all charges whatsoever during her natural life the use of one hundred and fifty acres of my said plantation commonly known or called by the name of Backs Row. Item I give to my said sister Mary Godfrey during her natural life and no longer the use and labour of three negroes Item I give to my brother William Wright my English mare called Nancy Dawson and my two riding horses and saddle and bridle Item I give to my friend William Guerin of Charles Town Merchant my black mare called Blaze Item I give to my brother Abraham Wright a grey mare called Calfax Item I give to my nephew Isaac Wright the use of my brother Isaac Wright a young grey Shanterson horse called Jockey Item my will further is and I do hereby order and direct that all the Rest Residue and Remainder of my estate both real and personal by me hereby not before disposed of be exposed to sale as soon as conveniently can be after my decease by my Executors hereafter named and that the monies arising therefrom shall in the first place be applied for and towards the payment and satisfaction of my debts and funeral charges and the overplus of such money after payment of my debts as aforesaid I do hereby direct and appoint the same to be equally divided to and amongst my Brothers and nephews of the name of Wright and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my two brothers Abraham and William Wright and my good friend William Guerin of Charles Town Merchant and the survivors and survivor of them Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void and null all former and other will or wills by me heretofore made declaring this and this only to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal The day and year first

It is my will that all my debts and funeral charges be first paid Item I give my negro girl named Sabina to my daughter Martha Millen to her and her heirs Item It is my will that my estate be equally divided share and share alike between my dearly beloved wife Mary Millen my daughter Martha Millen and the child my wife is pregnant with but if the child should be a boy then I give and bequeath my plantation at the Indian Land to him. Item it is my will that my wife share should be delivered to her as soon as my affairs are settled to be at her own disposal. Item It is my will that my daughter Martha do receive her part or portion at the age of eighteen or the day of marriage but if she dies before the day of marriage or the age of eighteen then her part to go to the child my wife is pregnant with. Item it is my will that if the child my wife is pregnant with be a boy then he shall receive his part or portion at the age of twenty one but if he should die before the age of twenty one unmarried then his part to go to my daughter Martha and if both of my children should die before the ages above mentioned
