 me with, I Give devise bequeath in form & manner following
 First I Will that all my Funeral Charges & Lawfull Debts be
 paid by my Executors hereafter Named. Item I give devise
 bequeath to my Brother John Heyward one half of my Tract
 of Land of Fifteen hundred & Twenty Nine acres Purchased of
 Mrs. Hannah Broughton & Thomas Broughton being part of
 a Tract of Four Thousand one hundred & Fifty acres Land laid
 out to Andrew Broughton Esq^r Deceased Situate Lying & Being in the
 Parish of St. Helena Sumner County Butting & bounding South
 Westerly on the Township line of Pinckney South Easterly on
 Land formerly Laid out to Robt Johnston Esq^r North Easterly on
 other part of of the Said larger Tract or Parcel of Land &
 North Westerly on Land formerly Laid out to Paul Kemps Esq^r
 The said one half of the said Tract to be taken of the South West
 side by a line paralleled with the Township line of Pinck-
 ney To him his heirs for ever. Item I give & bequeath
 to my Brother Samuel Heyward the other Half of the afore-
 said Tract of Fifteen hundred & Twenty Nine acres being the
 North East part of the said Tract Lying & Being Butting & bounding
 as aforesaid to him his heirs & assigns for ever.
 Item I Give & Devise to my Brother John Heyward one
 negro man Toke to him his heirs for ever
 Item I Give & devise to my Brother Samuel Heyward one negro
 woman named Eve one negro man named May one negro
 man named Jacob one negro Boy Dick & one negro Girl
 named Mintie to him his heirs for ever.
 Item I give & devise to my Nephew Thomas Heyward one
 negro Boy named _____ to him his heirs for ever.
 Item I give & devise to my Nephew William Heyward one
 negro Boy named Harrell to him his heirs for ever.
 Item I give & devise to my Nephew John Heyward one negro Boy
 named January to him his heirs for ever.
 Item I give & devise to my Niece Margaret Heyward one negro
 Girl named Miriah to her other heirs for ever
 Item I give & devise to my Niece Ann Heyward one negro Girl
 named Nancy to her other heirs for ever.
 Item I Give & Devise to my Niece Hester Heyward one negro Girl
 named Lizzie to her other heirs for ever.
 Item I Give devise bequeath to my Two Brothers John Heyward

I give and devise to my nephew Daniel Heyward one

Samuel Heyward all my Goods & Chattels &c All my Real & Personal Estate that shall be remaining to be Equally Divided between my Two Brothers John Heyward & Samuel Heyward to them & their Heirs for ever.

And lastly I constitute nominate & appoint my Two Loving Brothers Daniel Heyward & Thomas Heyward Executors to this my Last Will & Testament contained in Two Sheets of Paper In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Sixth Day of September anno Domini one Thousand Seven hundred & Sixty 1760

I Josiah Tomlinson of Fredericksburgh Township in Craven County in the Province of South Carolina being Sicks Weak in Body but of perfect Mind & Memory Pleased by almighty God for this space Considering the uncertainty of This mortal life knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make & publish this my Last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say in the first place I recommend my Soul to God who gave it me & my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a discreet manner as my Executors hereafter Named shall direct & as Touching Such worldly Substance as God hath given me I bequeath them in the following Manner First I order that all my just Debts & Funeral Expenses be Discharged Next I do bequeath unto my Son William Tomlinson a Tract of Land containing three Hundred acres situate lying being in Craven County on the North side of Wateree River in Fredericksburgh Township in the Province of South Carolina & bettering bounding now or formerly Southeastwardly on said River Northwardly part on Land granted to Daniel Brady part on Vacant Land North Eastwardly on Vacant Land & Southeastwardly on Land granted to Mark Catterton but my said Son William shall pay unto my Son Samuel Tomlinson one Hundred pounds Current Money of this Province which shall be paid as soon as my said Son Josiah arrives to the age of 21 years. Item I do bequeath unto my Son Samuel Tomlinson a Tract of Land containing one Hundred acres situate lying being in
