 I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching
 such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this
 life I impoverish & appoint my friends Thomas Holman & John Hunt and Hugh
 Ferguson my full Executors to this my last Will & Testament I will my
 Crop of rice now at home and money to discharge my lawful debts and if
 not sufficient a part of my stock I give & bequeath to my beloved son Barnaby
 Cockfield all my lands and houses & eleven negroes named as follow
 Painter, Venus, Rose, Prince, New, Flora, Dealer, Silly, Riddy, Prosper,
 Luamin's and a silver watch and two gold rings & two sets of silver shoe
 & knee Buckles together with all my stock & household goods excepting six
 cows & six sheep I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Cockfield four
 negroes named as follow, Gloc, Robin, Hagan, Monday & six Breeding
 cows & six sheep to be delivered to whosoever of age on the Day of her
 Marriage, Item in case my son Barnaby dies without issue his part
 shall then fall unto my brother Barnaby Cockfield I hereby revoke & disannul
 and make void all former wills & bequests by me made These only
 to be my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto

only for my last will and Testament (in manner & form following reciting
and annulling by these presents all and every Testament & Testaments will
or wills heretofore by me made and declared either by word or writing)
and none other and I wish & recommend my soul to almighty God in hopes
of joyful resurrection and my body to the earth to be buried in decent
Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named & now
doe the settling of my temporal Estate, and such goods Chattels and Debts as it
hath pleased God to bestow upon me, I do order give bequeath & dispose of the
same in manner and form as follows That is to say, I wish & will that all those
debts and dues that I owe to any manner of person or persons whatsoever
shall be paid or ordered to be paid within convenient time after my decease
by my Executors hereafter named. Item I give & bequeath unto my
beloved wife Sarah Whiteside all my Estate wholly & solely during the time
she shall continue under my name to maintain my children without any charge
to them Item I give & bequeath unto my five sons Thomas John William
Edward and Mace Whiteside all my lands to them & their heirs to be
equally divided betwixt them, paying unto their sisters Sarah Mary &
Elizabeth Whiteside the sum of two hundred pounds current money to each
of them at the day of their marriage I will that my son Moses shall not
paying no part of the two hundred pounds apiece to his sisters but to be paid
betwixt my other four sons Thomas John William & Edward to their Sister
I give also unto beloved wife Sarah Whiteside one negro woman named Kate
and her increase exclusive and I will that the said woman with her
increase do return & be equally divided among my children at my wifes death
and I will that all my personal Estate be equally divided amongst or between
my wife and children and at my wifes death that part that belonged
to
