I John Crawford of Craven County, in the Province of South Carolina being of perfect sense and memory, Thanks be to Almighty God; Do make this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following First and principally I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it, trusting through the merits of Christ, to receive full pardon for all my Sins, and my Body to be buried decently by the Directions of my Executors hereafter named, and what Estate it hath pleased God to bestow on me, after my just Debts and Funeral Charges are paid I give as followeth:

Item I leave unto my loving Wife Mary Crawford one third Part of my Lands during her natural Life or widowhood,

Item I leave to my said Wife Six Negroes, vizt. Joe, Doll Abraham Little Doll, Jenny & Mourning, during her natural Life or Widowhood, and also one third part of my household Goods, and one third part of my Stock of Cattle, Hogs and Horses, during her natural Life or Widowhood, and after her Marriage or Decease, the same to be equally divided among such of my Children as shall be then alive.

Item my Will and desire is, that the Tract of Land wherein my Son John Crawford lives on the lower side of Phillips Creek, together with the Stock and Five Negroes vizt. Jack, Manny, Paman, Abby & Stephen for which I made him a Deed of Gift some few days past to be the proper use of him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give to my son Thomas Crawford, the remainder part of the Tract of Land mentioned to John Crawford that lies above Phillips Creek, with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my said Son Thomas Crawford all my Land adjoining to Abraham Lundy, with the appurtenances thereto belonging.

Item I give unto my said Son Thomas Crawford one third part of my Stock, and my Two Large Boats and my Ferry Boat.

Item I give unto my said Son Thomas Crawford, Imphy, Moll, Hannah, Sarah, Nell to him and his heirs for ever.

Item, I give unto my son Michael Crawford my Manor House & Plantation, with Three hundred Acres of Land, wherein I now live with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him & his heirs for ever.

Item, I give unto my said Son Michael Crawford my Tract of Land on Naked Creek containing seven hundred & fifty acres to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my said Son Michael Crawford Five Negroes vizt. Natell, Jenny, George, Barbara, and Lucy, and one third Part of the

Stock to him, and his Heirs forever.

Item I give unto my Son ~~Michael Crawford~~ my Will, and Desire is, that my Lands on Lynch's Creek, be sold by my Executors for the Payment of my Debts, and that my said Executors have full power to convey the same.

Item My Will and Desire is, that Three hundred pounds which lies in Virginia, be equally divided between my Wife and Three Sons.

Item And I do constitute and appoint my well beloved Wife Mary Crawford my Executrix and my sons John & Thomas Crawford my whole and sole Executors of this my Last Will & Testament, disannulling and making void, all other Wills by me heretofore made.

In witness whereof I have herewith set my hand and Seal this Twentieth Day of October one thousand seven hundred and fifty six.

In the Name of God amen I Thomas Drayton of Saint Andrews Parish Esquire, being weak in Body but of sound mind, do make publish and Declare these presents to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking & making void, all other wills whatsoever by me at any time heretofore made.

First I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping for a blessed Immortality, through the merits and Intercession of my only Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ. My Body I give to the Earth to be decently buried in the presence of a few friends to be invited by my Exors. for that purpose.

Item it is my Will that the whole of my Estate Real and Personal be kept together until my Debts and the pecuniary Legacy hereinafter bequeathed to my Son in Law Edward Fenwick Esq^r are fully paid and satisfied; for which End and Purpose, I do hereby allot the Clear Annual Profits of my said Estate, after first deducting from the same, one hundred & forty pounds sterling, which I give and bequeath to my beloved wife to be paid her yearly by my Exors for the Support and Maintenance of herself and my son Thomas Drayton and also after deducting the sum of sixty pounds sterling, which I hereby give and bequeath to my Son John Drayton to be annually paid by my said Executors for his maintenance and education.

Item after payment of Debts and the legacy aforesaid. I do hereby give devise and bequeath my said Whole Estate in manner and form following that is to say. I give and Devise to my said Wife, all those two Tracts of Land on Ashley River wherein I now live, adjoining each other containing in the whole, Six hundred and sixty two acres, and also that piece of Cypress Swamp Land, lying above Raven's Bridge
