 of Colleton County of the Province of South Carolina being in
 Perfect health of Body mind & Memory thanks be given unto
 God therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body &
 Knowing That it is appointed for all men once to die do
 make & ordain this my last Will & Testament That is to say
 principally & first of all to give & recommend my Soul unto
 the Hands of Almighty God that gave it & my Body I
 recommend to the Earth to be Buried in Decent Christian
 Burial at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting
 but at the General resurrection, I shall receive the same
 again by the mighty power of God & as touching such Worldly
 Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me in This life
 I Give, devise & Dispose of the same in the following Manner
 First I Give & bequeath to hannah Glover my Dealy Belord
 Wife the one Fifth part of all my real & personal Estate
 after all my lawfull Debts & Funeral Charges is paid &
 my Belord Wife I appoint likewise Constitute make & ordain
 My Sole Executrix of this my Last Will & Testament Also I
 Give to my Well Belord Daughter & the Issue of her Body
 Elizabeth Taylor the one ~~Fifth~~^{part} of all my real &
 personal Estate after all my lawfull Debts & funeral Charges
 is paid & my Belord Wife I appoint likewise Constitute make
 & ordain my sole Executrix of this my Last Will & Testament
 And her to my only two hundred pounds my Daughter
 Elizabeth Taylor or her heirs is to allow out of her part to my
 Wife & the rest of my Children at the Dividing of my said Estate
 money to her in hand paid already as by a Bond & Negro Wench
 will appear Thomas Taylor whom I appoint one of my Executors
 of This my Last Will & Testament Sarah finely whom I likewise
 leave the one fifth part of my real & personal Estate & to the
 Issue of her Body after all my lawfull Debts & Funeral Charges
 is paid I likewise Constitute & ordain one of my Executors
 of This my Last Will & Testament John Finley rebacha Baron my Well Belord Daughters likewise
 leave the one fifth part of my Real & personal Estate & to the
 Issue of her Body after all my ^{lawfull} Debts & Funeral Charges is paid
 Likewise Constitute & ordain Jonathan Baron one of my Executors
 also I give to my Well Belord Daughter Hannah Golden the
 one ~~Fifth~~^{part} of my real & personal Estate after all my
 lawfull Debts & Funeral charges is paid & to the Issue of her Body
 Likewise Constitute make & ordain one of my Executors
 Peter Golden & I do hereby Constitute make & ordain & order
 That June & her Issue a Negro Woman name I sent to my
 Grand Daughter I do hereby ordain That my Grand Daughter
 Ann Smith Departing this life without Issue that said
 June & her Issue shall return to my Well Belord Wife & children
 & to the Issue of their Body & I do hereby utterly & totally
 revoke Disannul all & Every other former Testaments Wills
 & testacit Requests & Execution by me in any ways before named

 my Last Will & Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto

 blessed by God for the same do make publish & Declare this to
 be & contain my last Will & Testament in manner of form
 following First & principally when it shall please God to call me
 hence Assign my soul unto the Hand almighty Protection
 Hoping for the remission of my sins Thro the merits of my
 Saviour Jesus Christ & my Body I Commit to the Earth to be
 decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter
 named as to what worldly Estate it hath pleased God to
 bestow upon upon me I hereby give Devise & Bequeath the
 same as follows Viz: In the first place I do Give Bequeath
 unto Jane Davis of the Parish of Saint Stephen aforesaid to
 five Negro Slaves hereinafter named to Witt London & Nelly
 his wife, Johnny & Becky their children their children & the
 Negro Named Oley To have & to hold the same to the said
 Jane Davis her heirs executors & assigns forever
 Item it is my Will & Desir that my executors herein
 after named do keep all the rest & residue of my Estate
 together for the Space of Four of five Years after my decease
 & the yearly Profits & Income thereof after discharging necessary
 charges & expenses I hereby order & direct Shall be applied
 towards satisfaction of my just & lawful debts & the ones left to
 be put out at interest by my executors for the use & benefit
 of the Negroes as herein after mentioned Item it is my
 will that the said Jane Davis have leave to live & reside on
