The Second Day of March one thousand Seven hundred & fifty eight 1758 I John Glover of the parish of Saint Paul of Colleton County of the Province of South Carolina being in Perfect health of Body mind & Memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body & knowing That it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament That is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my Soul unto the Hands of Almighty God that Save it & my Body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in Decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting but at the General resurrection, I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me in This life I Give, devise & Dispose of the same in the following Manner, first I Give bequeath to Hanna Glover my Dearly Beloved Wife the one Fifth part of all my real & personal Estate after all my lawful Debts & Funeral Charges is paid & my Beloved Wife I appoint likewise constitute make & ordain my Sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament Also I Give to my Well Beloved Daughter & the Issue of her Body Elizabeth Taylor the one ~~fourth~~ fifth part of all my real & personal Estate after all my lawful Debts & funeral Charges is paid & my Beloved Wife I appoint likewise constitute make & ordain my Sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament ~~Also I Give to my~~ ~~only~~ ~~two~~ ~~hundred~~ ~~pounds~~ my Daughter Elizabeth Taylor or her heirs is to allow out of her part to my Wife & the rest of my Children at the Dividing of my said Estate money to her in hand paid already as by a Bond & Negro Vouch Will appear Thomas Taylor Whom I appoint one of my Executors of This my last Will & Testament Sara finely Whom I likewise leave the one fifth part of my real & personal Estate & to the Issue of her Body after all my lawful Debts & Funeral Charges is paid I likewise constitute & appoint one of my Exors, John Pintey rebacca, Baron my Well Beloved Daughter likewise leave the one fifth part of my Real & personal Estate & to the Issue of her Body after all my ^{lawful} Debts & Funeral Charges is paid I likewise constitute & ordain Jonathan Baron one of my Executors also I Give to my Well Beloved Daughter Hannah Golden the one Fiftieth part of my real & personal Estate after all my lawful Debts & Funeral charges is paid & to the Issue of her Body I likewise constitute make & ordain one of my Executors Peter Golden & I do hereby constitute make & ordain & order That Jane & her Issue a Negro Woman home I give to my Grand Daughter I do hereby ordain That my Grand Daughter Ann Smith Departing this life without Issue That Said Jane & her Issue shall return to my Well Beloved Wife & Children or to the Issue of their Body & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke Disannul all & Every other former Testaments Wills Legacies Bequests & Execution by me in any ways before named

Negro Maides Eliza To have & to hold the same to the said
Jane Davis her Heirs Exors assigns forever
Item it is my Will & Desire that my Exors herein
after named do keep all the rest residue of my Estate
together for the Space of Term of five Year after my Decease
& the yearly Profits & Income thereof After paying necessary
charges & Expenses I hereby order & direct shall be applied
towards Satisfaction of my just & lawful debts & the surplus to
be put out at Interest by my Executors for the use & benefit
of the legatees as hereinafter mentioned Item it is my
Will that the said Jane Davis have leave to live & reside on
