In the name of God amen I John Logans of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina Taylor being sick & weak of Body but perfectly in my senses; Do make publish and Declare this to be and contain my Last Will and Testament. I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty God, my Body I order devoutly Buried at the Discretion of my Exors. Herein after named, hoping for a Glorious Resurrection to Eternal Life through the merits and mediation of my blessed Saviour (and Redeemer) Jesus Christ, and the worldly estate which almighty God of his Bounty and Favour has bestowed on me, after all and singular my Just Debts and Funeral Expenses, are fully & ultimately paid and satisfied. I give devise and bequeath, in manner and form following that is to say *Imprimis*, I give and bequeath unto my mother Isabella Lennox (otherwise called formerly Isabella Logans) Widow of William Lennox late of Glasgow in the Kingdom of Great Britain huckle Weaver deceased, the sum of Ten pounds of Sterling money of Great Britain aforesaid. Item I give and bequeath unto Bertha Milner the wife of John Milner of Charles Town aforesaid. Tinsmith, all and singular the wearing apparel of my Late Wife Sarah Logans upon the special Trust and confidence nevertheless that she the said Bertha Milner do as soon as may be after my decease, equally and impartially share and divide the said wearing apparel between and among the Sisters of my said Late Wife Sarah, now residing in this Province and to and for no other use, Intent; Trust & purpose whatsoever. Item all the rest surplus and residue of my Estate real and personal, whatsoever and whensover, I give devise and bequeath unto and among the Children of my three Sisters vizt: Isabella Moncrief formerly called Isabella Logan, the wife of John Moncrief of Glasgow aforesaid Taylor; Janet Stinson formerly called Janet Logan, the wife of John Stinson of Glasgow aforesaid huckle Weaver, and Mary Stinson formerly called Mary Logan the wife of Robert Stinson of Glasgow aforesaid huckle Weaver, to be equally shared and divided between and every the Children of my said Three Sisters Isabella Moncrief, Janet Stinson and Mary Stinson, and their several and respective heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns for ever.

Item it is my Will, in case my mother Isabella Lennox should depart this life before me that the legacy to her herein before given, shall become as part of the Surplus of my Estate and as such pass under the Residuary Clause of this my Will. Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Walter Gilchrist and John, Wapier of Charles Town aforesaid Executors of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and other Wills by me at any time heretofore made, and declaring this only to be and contain my Last Will and Testament comprized in one sheet of Ammon paper.

 Frederick's Parish South Carolina, being presently in health, but
 persuaded of my being subject to mortality with the rest of mankind,
 have thought fit to settle my worldly Goods and Effects by latter
 Will & Testament.

Know therefore all whom it may or shall concern
 That I ordain and Will in manner following wit: That after
 the payment of all my Lawful Debts, I bequeath and leave to
 Rachel Rae, my beloved Spouse all and whole of my real and
 personal Estate, Goods and Effects whatsoever, whether consisting in
 Lands, Slaves, Chattels liberty, Household furniture or sums of
 money, that shall appertain or be due unto me at the Time of
 my Decease, whenever it shall happen, and that for her own
 proper use, and to be at her own Disposal, hereby excluding all
 other Friends and Relations, that any manner of way may
 pretend a share in any of my worldly Goods and Effects, and I
 ordain and Will the said Rachel Rae and Archibald Baird
 of George Town Esqr. my sole Exors and Intromettors with all
 my worldly Effects whatsoever, that shall belong to me at the time
 of my decease, empowering them to do every thing proper and needful in
 Law for executing the premises. And I ordain this as my last
 Will and Testament, disannulling all other Testaments, that may
 have been made by me previous to the Date hereof.

 Williamsburgh, this Fifth Day of February one thousand
 seven hundred and Fifty five years.
