

In the name of God Amen the twenty fourth day of January 1761 I John Paterson of the County Berks Merchant being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me in this life I give dismiss & dispose of the same in the following manner & form. First I leave my two daughters to my mother Mary Remington to be brought up at her discretion and I desire William Paterson may while he lives stay & be with them & that may have every sufficient for them out of my Estate for to live well on. And I do make and appoint Wm Hendrix & Samuel Cannon my whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament to manage all my affairs & all debts & charge as is Defrayed & what remains to be taken the best care of for my children when they come to age and then to be Equally divided between them & my desire is that they have as good learning as can be got for them. Witnessing all other former Wills & Testament I do make & Ordain this my last Will Signed & sealed the day & year above Written.

I Philip Raiford of Craven County and province of South Carolina being in perfect Health praise be to God do make this my last Will & Testament as followeth Inprimis I give to my daughter Sarah Raiford all them parcel of Cattle which is marked for her at Abraham Combs who hath them in his care and marked in the right Ear with a swoller fork & a upper half prong and Brand three Together with their Increase I turn & give to my daughter Rachel Raiford all them parcel of Cattle among my home stock marked for her with a swoller fork & half prong under & over in the right ear and Branded three Together with their Increase. Also I give to my three sons viz Philip Ephraim Raiford William Raiford and Matthew Raiford all my young Cows & Calves to each of them to be paid & marked for them as soon as possible after my decease by my Exors Hereafter named likewise I give dismiss & bequeath to my said son Philip Ephraim one half of that remaining part of that tract of land & purchase of Charles Wells that is to say One hundred & fifty acres adjoining Broad river with the Plantation thereon And the other half of the above said tract which is one hundred & fifty acres
