Know therefore all whom it may or shall concern
 That I ordain and Will in manner following wit: That after
 the payment of all my Lawful Debts, I bequeath and leave to
 Rachel Rae, my beloved Spouse all and whole of my real and
 personal Estate, Goods and Effects whatsoever, whether consisting in
 Lands, Slaves, Chattels liberty, Household furniture or sums of
 money, that shall appertain or be due unto me at the Time of
 my Decease, whenever it shall happen, and that for her own
 proper use, and to be at her own Disposal, hereby excluding all
 other Friends and Relations, that any manner of way may
 pretend a share in any of my worldly Goods and Effects, and I
 ordain and Will the said Rachel Rae and Archibald Baird
 of George Town Esqr. my sole Exors and Intromettors with all
 my worldly Effects whatsoever, that shall belong to me at the time
 of my decease, empowering them to do every thing proper and needful in
 Law for executing the premises. And I ordain this as my last
 Will and Testament, disannulling all other Testaments, that may
 have been made by me previous to the ~~Death~~ Date hereof.

 seven hundred and Fifty five years.

I John Crawford of Craven County, in the Province of South Carolina being of perfect sense and memory, Thanks be to Almighty God; Do make this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following First and principally I recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it, trusting through the merits of Christ, to receive full pardon for all my Sins, and my Body to be buried decently by the Directions of my Executors hereafter named, and what Estate it hath pleased God to bestow on me, after my just Debts and Funeral Charges are paid I give as followeth:

Item I leave unto my loving Wife Mary Crawford, one third Part of my Lands during her natural Life or widowhood,

Item I leave to my said Wife Six Negroes, vizt. Joe, Doll Abraham Little Doll, Jenny & Mourning, during her natural Life or Widowhood, and also one third part of my household Goods, and one third part of my Stock of Cattle, Hogs and Horses, during her natural Life or Widowhood, and after her Marriage or Decease, the same to be equally divided among such of my Children as shall be then alive.

Item my Will and desire is, that the Tract of Land wherein my Son John Crawford lives on the lower side of Phill's Creek, together with the Stock and Five Negroes vizt. Jack, Manny, Paman, Abby & Stephen for which I made him a Deed of Gift some few days past to be the proper use of him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give to my son Thomas Crawford, the remainder part of the Tract of Land mentioned to John Crawford that lies above Phill's Creek, with the appurtenances therunto belonging to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my said Son Thomas Crawford all my Land adjoining to Abraham Lundy, with the appurtenances therunto belonging.

Item I give unto my said Son Thomas Crawford one third part of my Stock, and my Two Large Boats and my Ferry Boat.

Item I give unto my said Son Thomas Crawford, Imphy, Moll, Hannah, Sarah, Nell to him and his heirs for ever.

Item, I give unto my son Michael Crawford my Manor House & Plantation, with Three hundred Acons of Land, wherein I now live with the appurtenances therunto belonging to him & his heirs forever.

Item, I give unto my said Son Michael Crawford my Tract of Land on Naked Creek containing seven hundred fifty acons to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my said Son Michael Crawford Five Negroes vizt. Natell, Jenny, George, Barbara, and Lucy, and one third Part of the
