 it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the Discretion  
 of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall  
 receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching  
 such worldly Estate wherewithal it hath pleased God to bless me  
 in this life I give and bequeath to Elizabeth Ray my Dearly  
 beloved Wife my Black Horse called Old Bob with a Bridle & Saddle  
 And also a Bed and Furniture also I give and Bequeath to my Brother  
 Peter Ray in the following manner & form on Black Horse called  
 Gilder Ray also I give & bequeath to my Brother Nichole Ray a  
 Black Horse called Duck Also I give and Bequeath to my Dearly  
 beloved Father John Ray all the Debts he owes me, after those  
 Legacies are taken out of my Estate I give and Bequeath to Elizabeth  
 Ray my dearly beloved wife half my whole Estate hattel Horse  
 Negroes and lands and money also I give and Bequeath in the same  
 manner & form to my Dearly beloved son John Ray Sen. The one  
 Half of my Estate after the above Legacies are paid, whom I appoint to  
 be my Executors in the following manner John Mathews and  
 Peter Ray and George King of this my last Will and Testament,  
 Duly to Swallow Revoke & Disannull all & every other former testament  
 Will & Legacies Requests and Executors by me in any ways before this  
 time named Willed and bequeathed Ratifying & Confirming this and  
 no other to be my last Will and Testament In witness Whereof  
 have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year above written.
