I Joseph Huggins of Prince Georges Parish Craven County in the
 Province of South Carolina Planter being in perfect health mind & memory
 thanks be given unto God for the same, but calling unto mind the
 Mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do
 make & ordain this my last will & Testament and it is my will that it should
 be deemed by all as such. That is to say Principally I give & recommend
 my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend
 to the Earth to be Buried in a Decent Christian Manner at the discretion and
 direction of my Executors hereafter named; and as touching such worldly
 estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give
 demise & dispose of the same in the following manner. Inprimis I will that all
 my debts and funeral charges be paid & discharged by my Executors hereinafter
 named, after my Decease. Item I give demise & Bequeth unto my beloved
 Nephew Joseph Huggins eldest son of my Bro^r Mark Huggins and
 to his heirs and assigns forever all my Estate Real and personal
 That is to say all my lands Tenements and Hereditaments
 situate on Water and elsewhere in the province of South Carolina
 together with all my slaves stocks of cattle Horses Hogs sheep
 and so forth with all the rest & residue of my moveable Goods
 Goods & Chattels and personal estate whatsoever & wheresoever
 to his & their only use and behoof forever; provided he arrives
 to the age of twenty one years. But if my said Nephew Joseph
 Huggins should die before he attains to the age of twenty one
 years, my will & meaning is, that all the above Real and personal estate my present
 property shall devolve descend & belong to my Nephew Henry Spry Samuel Spry and

Royal, I pray to be equally divided between them to their only use benefit
 and Relief, and to every of their Heirs & Assignes forever. Item I do
 hereby nominate and appoint my very friends Col.^l Elias Henry Capt.ⁿ
 John Henry & my nephew Henry I pray Executors of this my last will
 and Testament, and trustees for my said Nephew Joseph Huggins
 Minor, who is to be maintained & Educated out of the Produce & profits
 arising out of the aforesaid Real & Personal Estate during his minority
 after my decease. And I hereby declare this to be my last will
 and Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Joseph Huggins Sen.^r have
 hereunto set my hand & seal the twenty fifth Day of April in the
 year of our Lord ^{God} one thousand seven hundred & fifty eight

 who have voluntarily of my own accord have enlisted in His Majesties
 Service in the Carolina Regiment under the Command of Capt.ⁿ Resae
 doarden & dispose of my worldly goods which it hath pleased God
 to endue me with in the following manner Impremis I do
 Will & bequeath to William Tomilson son to Josiah Tomilson
 the benefit of fifty acres of land situate & joining the mill at
 Pine tree creek to be disposed of by his father for his sons use and
 benefit Item I also bequeath to William Mary & Ann Tomilson
 all my moveable effects to be equally divided among them
 Share & share alike and I do nominate and appoint Sam^l
 Nelly Esq.ⁿ & Josiah Tomilson my sole Executors to see this my
 last will & Testament truly & faithfully performed and all
 other wills & Testaments I do utterly revoke & disannul and
 order this as my last will and testament it being signed
 with my hand sealed with my seal the Day & year above
 written
