I Josiah Tomlinson of Fredericksburgh Township in Craven County in the Province of South Carolina being Sicks Weak in Body but of perfect Mind & Memory Pleased by almighty God for this space Considering the uncertainty of This mortal life knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make & publish this my Last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say in the first place I recommend my Soul to God who gave it me & my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a discreet manner as my Executors hereafter Named shall direct & as Touching Such worldly Substance as God hath given me I bequeath them in the following Manner First I order that all my Just Debts & Funeral Expenses be Discharged Next I do bequeath unto my Son William Tomlinson a Tract of Land containing three Hundred acres situate lying being in Craven County on the North side of Wateree River in Fredericksburgh Township in the Province of South Carolina & bettering bounding now or formerly Southeastwardly on said River Northwardly part on Land granted to Daniel Brady part on Vacant Land North Eastwardly on Vacant Land & South Eastwardly on Land granted to Mark Catterton but my said Son William shall pay unto my Son Samuel Tomlinson one Hundred pounds Current Money of this Province which shall be paid as soon as my said Son Josiah arrives to the age of 21 years. Item I do bequeath unto my Son Samuel Tomlinson a Tract of Land containing one Hundred acres situate lying being in

Crann County on the North side of Potomac River in Frederickburg
Township Putting & Bounding Southwardly on said River
Northwardly on Land Granted to John Hudson Northwardly
on Vacant Land & Southeastwardly on the aforesaid Tract
of three Hundred acres of land Item I give & Bequeath unto
my Son Josiah Tomlinson a Tract of Land ^{one hundred and} containing, situate
lying & being in Frederickburg Township in Crann County in the
Province aforesaid Putting & Bounding to the Southward on
Land laid out to John Bennett Bennett to the Southeastward
part on Land laid out to Patrick McCormick & part on
Vacant Land to the Northeastward now or formerly on Vacant
Land & to the Northward formerly part on Vacant Land
& part on Land laid out to Bryant Ostrak also I Give &
Bequeath unto my said Son Josiah a Tract of Land containing
fifty Acres in Frederickburg Township Crann County Province
aforesaid Bounded Southeastward on Land laid out to Rhett
Milhous Southward on Land laid out to Patrick McCormick
Northward on Land Granted to John Black & Northward
on Vacant Land also I Give to my said Son Josiah my Cow
& Calf & their Increase from my Decese. Item I Give unto
my Son William Tomlinson my largest Feather Bed & Calf
my Plantation & Carpenters Tools & Utensils of Husbandry two
Cows & Calves which are called his own & my Long folding
piece. Item I give unto my Son Samuel Tomlinson a
Feather Bed w^h was his Mothers & Half my Plantation &
Carpenters Tools & Utensils of Husbandry also one Cow & Calf
besides what are called his own & my small folding piece.
Item I Give unto my Daughter Mary Tomlinson two Cows
& one Calf which are called her own & one Feather Bed & a
Sambzen Town which was her Mothers. Item I Give &
Bequeath unto my Daughter Ann Tomlinson two Cows & Calves
which are called her own & one Feather Bed. Item I Give unto my
Daughter Sarah one Cow & Calf. Item I Give unto my Daughter
Rebeckah one Cow & Calf & a Hay mow & her Calf. Item all
the rest & remainder of my worldly Goods & Chattels I Give &
Bequeath unto my Daughters Mary Tomlinson, Ann Tomlinson,
Sarah Tomlinson, & Rebeckah Tomlinson to be Equally Divided
amongst them. Lastly I Nominate constitute & appoint Samuel
Milhous & John Milhous to my Executors of this my last
Will & Testament & I do hereby revoke & annul all former
Wills by me made & my said Executors shall be paid all
Expenses out of my ~~own~~ Estate. It is my Will That if either
or any of my Sons should die without Issue or before they
arrive of age their part shall be divided amongst the surviving
Sons & if all my Sons should die as aforesaid their part shall
be Equally Divided amongst my daughter & if any or either of
my Daughters should die before they are married or arrive of age
their part shall be Divided Equally amongst my surviving
Daughters & if all my Daughters should so die their parts
shall go to my Sons to be Equally Divided amongst them

Williamson of Prince William Executors of this my last Will
& Testament & I do hereby declare it to be my Will that my
said Executors should pay all my just Debts & funeral Expenses
with all convenient Speed after my Decese. Item I
do bequeath unto my Son Thomas Hutson & his heirs
forever all my Plantation or Tract of Land in the parish of
Prince William in Granville County Containing Eight hundred
