 Wife Mary Anderson shall have her maintenance on this plantation  
 wherein I now live during her life & to be paid fifty pounds a year  
 by my Exors out of my Estate for her own private use during her  
 life and likewise the use of a Negro woman named Phoebe during  
 her life likewise I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Mary  
 Anderson her choice of my Riding Horses with her Saddle and the best  
 Bed in the House with its furniture. Item I will give & bequeath  
 to my Eldest Daughter Jane Anderson this Tract of Land or plantation  
 wherein I now live likewise all other my Tracts of land that I am  
 Possessed of Item I give & bequeath to my youngest Daughter Sarah  
 Anderson twelve of the choice of my slaves to be chosen for her by my  
 Exors that is to put her on and Equality with my Eldest Daughter  
 Jane to whom I leave all my lands Item I give & bequeath the  
 Residue of my Estate that is the Remaining Negroes with my stock of  
 Cattle Horses Hogs Ship Household goods &c to be equally divided  
 between my Daughters Jane & Sarah Anderson and to this my  
 last Will & Testament I constitute & appoint John Withers William  
 Matthews & William Anderson as my Exors of this my last Will & Testament  
 And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & Every  
 other former Testaments Wills Legacies Requests & Exors by me in  
 any ways before this named. Witness & bequeathed Ratifying and  
 Confirming this to be my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof  
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and year within  
 written.

 manner following Also I will order & direct that all & singular the rest and  
 Residue of my estate Real & Personal whatsoever & wheresoever be sold  
 as soon as is conveniently may by my Exors. And that out of the money to arise  
 from the sale thereof all my just debts & funeral Expenses be first paid  
 & discharged. First I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Bro. William  
 Slaze one shilling Sterling Item I also give & bequeath unto my loving  
 Sister Esther Wilson one shilling Sterling with one full of suit of mourning  
 Item I give & bequeath unto my loving Bro. James Slaze one shilling  
 Sterling. Item I give & bequeath Partly unto my loving Sister Susannah  
 Bond one shilling Sterling. Item I lastly of all give & bequeath

unto my loving Niece Mary Glaze & my loving Nephew John Glaze  
The Daughter & Son of my loving Bro: John Glaze The Rest & Remainder of the  
money arising from the sale of my Estate, which I do hereby allot to be equally  
Divided between them. The said Mary Glaze & John Glaze to them & to their heirs  
for ever. Lastly I nominate constitute & appoint Henry Livingston and  
M<sup>rs</sup> Mary Glaze Gov & Executrix of this my last will and Testament. On  
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal on the fourth  
day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred  
Sixty two.

& bequeath to my son John Splatt & my Daughter Mary Splatt nineteen negroes  
the remaining part of my stock of Cattle to be equally divided (my debts being first  
paid) between the said John & Mary. Thirdly I give & bequeath to my beloved son John  
Splatt two lots of land & one fifth part of a lot of land wherein M<sup>r</sup> David Maybank  
now lives their situation in Jacksonburg (my debts being first paid) Fourthly I give  
& bequeath unto William Eberson my debts being first paid one Roan horse with  
I bought of M<sup>r</sup> James M<sup>r</sup> Eberson all the rest & residue of my personal estate  
I give & bequeath unto my beloved son John & Daughter Mary Splatt to be equally  
divided between them (my debts being first paid) and I do hereby appoint David  
Maybank & William Eberson Executors to this my last will & Testament whereunto  
I have set my hand & seal the day & year above written.
