I Margaret Glass of Charles Town in the Province
of South Carolina Widow being of sound and disposing
mind and memory this great in God (Thanks be to God)
do make and publish this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say Inprimis
I do desire and request my Executors hereinafter
named that after my decease my body may be
decently interred and my funeral expences as small
as all such my funeral debts to be quick paid and discharged
out of my said estate. I give and devise unto my
two children Frederick and Henrietta Glass all my
bed furniture and all my wearing apparels to be legally
distributed)

Distributed amongst them as to the rest of my residue of my
estate in the Province of South Carolina I desire my Executors
to make the most of by sale for the support of and maintenance
of my said two children to be applied for them for their instruct in
Cloathing and keeping till they come to the age of maturity
which is to say my son till twenty one years old my daughter
till sixteen years old or day of marriage which shall first happen
I do further give and devise to my said children all such
household furniture now lying and being in Europe
in the Dukedom of Wirtemberg and parish of Rudwigs-
burg and village called Pfligfeld near the said town of
Rudwigsburg and near to Archberg my property and all
such Duties, Rights claims and demands with all its
appurtenances hereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining
with the Reversion and reversions Remainder and Remainders
Rack and Issue which shall then be due or owing by
by Jacob Raff in whose Custody the said messuage was in
possession of or in whose possession the same now may be
by such person or persons whatsoever I do further empower
my said Executors as Trustees for my said two children to
one or more attorney or attorneys for them to each
ask and demand with full power and authority the said
Messuage Rentes Tenements lying and being in the Dukedom
of Wirtemberg in Germany and parish aforesaid and to
Empower the said attorney or attorneys to ask for them and to
dispose of the same for the use of my said children and to
make a return of such sale by Publick outcry to the highest
bidder being accomplished two years after the departure
of each attorney or attorneys with a proper account and
discharge in that disposal and sale of the said land
Messuage Tenements as aforesaid and further I desire my
Executors or either of them to receive all such debts as shall
appear be due and owing to me for the use of my said children

Children and to bind them out to some Housecraft
Trade and as they come of age as aforesaid if my son
should happen to die before his Sister then all such
Estate shall be the property of my daughters and so in
the like manner if it should happen that my daughter
should die before her Brother then I do hereby nominate
and appoint my three loving friends John Werner
George John and Jacob Wirth to be my lawful
Executors and Trustees of my Last Will and Testament
Desiring Requesting them to do with their utmost
Power fidelity and good conduct to get for my said
Children to the request of my said last will and Testament
by me here made for their advantage as in their Powers
Right In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
and subscribed my hand and seal this sixteenth day
of February in the year of our Lord one thousand
Seven hundred and Sixty four.

In the Name of God amen May the
second day in the fourth year of King George the Third's
Reign and in year of our Lord one thousand Seven
hundred and Sixty four I Frederick Stroule of Charles
Town in the Province of South Carolina Bricklayer, being
sick and weak in body, but (Blessed be God) of sound and
disposing

Disposing mind and memory and Considering the uncertainty
of this transitory life and the certainty of death do make and
Ordain this my Last Will and Testament. Principally
Commending my immortal spirit to God who gave it in and
through the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ my blessed
Saviour and Redeemer on whom I rely for the pardon and
remission of all my sins and for Eternal life and salvation my body
at death I commit to the earth to be buried in a decent and
Christian manner as my Executors hereinafter named shall
see proper in hope of a glorious Resurrection to life and
Immortality and as to all my moveable Estate and such lands and
Tenements, goods and Chattels as it hath pleased God to bestow
upon me. I give and Ordain that the same and every part
and parcel thereof shall go and be disposed of in such manner
and form as is hereinafter respectively mentioned that is to say
First I will and desire that all my just debts and General
Expences shall be duly paid and discharged and for that
End and purpose I hereby direct authorize and Empower my
Executors hereinafter named and the survivor of them his Executors
and administrators with all convenient Expedition after
my decease, to sell and dispose of, for the most money that
can be gotten and to the highest Bidden and also to grant
and convey in due form and manner of law to such person
his or her Heirs and assigns absolutely forever as he or they shall
see fit not only all that my messuage or Houses and
part of a town lot of land situate on the west side of King
Street in the said town together with the Hereditaments and
Appurtenances thereto belonging but also to sell and dispose
of for the most monies that can be obtained for the same all my
Realty Chattels and slaves except only such articles and parts
thereof
