remainder of Daniel Boob's servitude bond his indenture provided
nevertheless that he the said James, followe the calling & employment
of a butcher otherwise the said Daniel Boob's time and
indenture to be disposed of to the best advantage, and the money arising
therefrom to be equally divided as before mentioned amongst them all
Item it is also my desire that my son John do take into his care
my daughter Catherine and at her own proper cost and charge
find and provide for the said Catherine every thing necessary as meat
drink cloathing, schooling, washing and lodging untill she attains
to the age of fourteen years, And further I do hereby utterly disavow
reprieve and disanul all and every other former wills Testaments
Bequests and Bequests by me in any waye before willing & bequeathed
And I do likewise constitute make and ordain my said Executors
and Executrix to this my last will and Testament viz: my well beloved
son and daughter John and Margaret Oliver to each an Executor and
Executrix, to all and every of the aforesaid articles by me Ratifying
and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament
