 duly made and executed by between my said Husband by the name of
 Tho: Rloyd of the Town in the Province of South Carolina Gentlemen
 of the one part & one Anthony Matthews (now deceased) by the name
 of Anthony Matthews of the same town & place Leg^r of the other
 part and bearing Date the twenty fourth day of March which was
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty nine
 to me the said Mary Rloyd given & granted do make & ordain this my
 last Will & Testament in manner & form following to wit, This my express will
 & do hereby order & direct that my Executors & Executors hereafter
 mentioned & appointed shall forthwith & with all convenient speed after
 my decease pay off discharge & satisfy all & every my just & lawful debts
 After payment & satisfaction whereas I give devise & bequeath unto
 my beloved Daughten Martha Matthews Rloyd all & singular my
 estate both real & personal of every nature & kind whatsoever &
 whosoever of which I now am or at the time of my death may be
 possessed or interested in or entitled unto by any ways or means whatsoever
 to be delivered & to my said Daughten by my said Ex^{rs} & Ex^{ors} when
 & as soon as my said Daughten shall full come to the age of Eighteen
 Years or day of Marriage which shall first happen. To have and
 to hold the same & every part & parcel thereof unto my said Daughten
 Martha Matthews Rloyd her heirs & assigns forever. But in case my
 said Daughten Martha Matthews Rloyd shall happen to die before she
 attains to the age of eighteen years or unmarried then I give devise
 & bequeath all & singular my said Estate both real & personal unto
 my son Thomas Rloyd to have & to hold the same & every part
 & parcel thereof unto my said son Tho: Rloyd his heirs & assigns
 forever. And if my said son Tho: Rloyd shall happen to die before
 he attains to the age of twenty one years then I give devise &
 bequeath

bequeath the same unto & amongst my Brothers James Matthews & John Matthews
 & my Brother in law Alexander Mountbain equally & be divided between & amongst them
 their heirs Ex^{rs} Adm^{rs} & assigns share & share alike. Item This my express will
 & do hereby order & direct that if my said Husband shall at any time or times after my decease
 claim challenge or demand the Partition Case, Magagement & Government of
 my said Daughten Martha Matthews Rloyd that then & in such case my
 said Ex^{rs} & Ex^{ors} nor any or either of them nor the survivors of them
 shall not appropriate dispose of nor apply any part of my said Estate to
 wards the support & maintenance of my said Daughten during the
 the time she may remain with or be under the tuition & Government of
 my said Husband. But that it shall & may be lawful to & for my said
 Ex^{rs} & Ex^{ors} to return in their own hands custody & possession my
 said Estate & for the use of my said Daughten until such time as my
 said Daughten shall attain to the age of Eighteen years or day of Marriage
 as aforesaid. And lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my beloved
 Mother Elizabeth Mountbain & David James Esquire Ex^{rs} & Ex^{ors} of
 this my last Will & Testament and guardians of the person & estate
 of my said Daughten Martha Matthews Rloyd. hereby revoking cancelling
 & making void all & every will & wills heretofore by me at
 any time made ratifying confirming and allowing this & this only
 to be & contain my last Will & Testament
