in Considerance and by virtue of the several Powers and  
Authoritatis in and by a certain Deed or Instrument of writing  
duly made and executed by me between my said Husband by the name of  
Tho: Lloyd of the Town in the Province of South Carolina Gentleman  
of the one part & one Anthony Matthews (now deceased) by the name  
of Anthony Matthews of the same Town & place Leg<sup>r</sup> of the other  
part also bearing Date the twenty fourth day of March which was  
in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred & forty nine  
to me the said Mary Lloyd given & granted do make & ordain this my  
last Will & Testament in manner & form following to wit This my express will  
& desire I do hereby ordain & direct that my Executrix & Executor herein after  
mentioned & appointed shall forthwith & with all convenient speed after  
my decease pay off discharge & satisfy all & every my just & lawful debts  
After payment & satisfaction whereof to give unto & bequeath unto  
my beloved Daughter Martha Matthews Lloyd all & singular my  
estate both real & personal of every nature & kind whatsoever &  
wherever of which I now am or at the time of my death may be  
possessed or interested in or entitled unto by any wayes or meane whatsoever  
To be delivered to her my said Daughter by my hand by & to or when  
as soon as my said Daughter shall fall unto the age of eighteen  
years enday of Marriage which shall first happen To have and  
to hold the same & every part & parcel thereof unto my said Daughter  
Martha Matthews Lloyd her heirs & assigns forever But in case my  
said Daughter Martha Matthews Lloyd shall happen to die before she  
attains to the age of eighteen years or unmarried they I give devise  
& bequeath all & singular my said Estate both real & personal unto  
my son Thomas Lloyd to have & to hold the same & every part  
& parcel thereof unto my said son Tho: Lloyd his heirs & assigns  
forever And if my said son Tho: Lloyd shall happen to die before  
he attains to the age of twenty one years then I give devise &  
bequeath

bequeath the same unto & amongst my Brothers James & John Mathews  
my Brother in law Alexander Moultrie equally to be divided between them  
their Heirs & Assigns there & share alike Item this my express will  
desire that if my said Husband shall at any time or times after my decease  
claim challenge or demand the tuition Care Management & Government of  
my said Daughter Martha Mathews Lloyd that then & in such case my  
said Esq<sup>r</sup> & Esq<sup>r</sup> nor any or either of them nor the survivors of them  
shall not appropriate dispose of nor apply any part of my said Estate to  
wards the support & maintenance of my said Daughter during the  
time she may remain with or be under the tuition & Government of  
my said Husband But that it shall & may be lawful to for my said  
Esq<sup>r</sup> & Esq<sup>r</sup> to return in their own hands custody & possession my  
said Estate to & for the use of my said Daughter until such time as my  
said Daughter shall attain to the age of eighteen years on day of Marriage  
as aforesaid And lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my beloved  
Mother Elizabeth Moultrie & David Greene Esquire Esq<sup>r</sup> & Esq<sup>r</sup> of  
this my last Will & Testament and guardians of the person & estate  
of my said Daughter Martha Mathews Lloyd hereby revoking cancelling  
& making void all & every will & wills heretofore by me at  
any time made ratifying confirming and allowing this & this only  
to be & contain my last Will & Testment
