In the Name of God amen, I Moses Audubert of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina, Gentleman being infirm in body but of sound and disposing mind and Memory, Blessed be God, Considering the fluctuancy of this transitory life and the certainty of death do make, publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following Principally being truly sorry for all my sins and humbly asking Pardon and forgiveness of the same I commend my immortal Spirit into the hands of God, the Father and Lord thereof, in and through Jesus Christ his only Son, my dear Saviour and Redeemer on whom I rely for the Pardon of my sins and for Eternal Life and Salvation And my body at death I commit to the Grave to be decently and in a Christian manner, buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named hoping for a glorious Resurrection to life and immortality by the mighty power of God And as to all my worldly Estate Real and Personal, Goods Chattels Monies Rights and Credits wherewith I have pleased God to bless me, in this life, I will and desire that the same, and every part and parcel thereof, shall go and be disposed of

as hereinafter respectively mentioned given and directed. My will is that and desire that all my just debts and funeral Expenses shall be well and duly paid and discharged as soon as conveniently may be after my decease, and that the several legacies, Bequests, devises and other Articles and directions contained in this my said last Will and Testament be carried into Execution paid and fulfilled as soon as possibly and conveniently can be done when I give and bequeath unto my Executors hereinafter named and appointed and the survivors and survivor of them and the Executors and Administrators of such survivor, the sum of one hundred pounds current money of this Province upon the Special Trust and Confidence hereinafter that he or they shall and do pay and distribute the same faithfully to and amongst such poor and needy People as he or they shall judge to be proper and suitable objects of Charity and good works. Item I give and bequeath unto my loving Brother Isaac Audubert of Boston in New England, the sum of two thousand, five hundred pounds current money of this Province, as also all my wearing apparel, not otherwise specifically given or bequeathed, in or by this my said last Will and Testament. Item I will and direct my Executors hereinafter named and the survivors and survivor of them his Executors or administrators to draw up, on the Account and Receipt of my Estate, the sum or value of five hundred pounds Sterling to be paid in Britain there, by them or him, to be directed into Bank Stock in the Bank of England until my three loving Nephews Philip Audubert Isaac Audubert Jun^r and Moses Audubert sons of my said Brother Isaac Audubert shall respectively attain the age of twenty one years, and when and as often ~~after~~ as any of them or the survivors or survivor of them my said three Nephews shall attain his said age of twenty one years, then my said Executors or Executor shall draw or cause to be drawn out a proportional part or share of such Bank Stock and of the increase thereof, for such nephew so coming of age and pay over to the same to him which in such case I give and bequeath unto him forever and if none of my said Nephews shall attain his age of twenty one years, then and not otherwise I further give and bequeath all the said five hundred pounds Bank Stock and the increase of the same, to be received and paid over, by my said Executors or Executor unto the survivors of my said three Nephews above named

Named, his Executors or administrators I am I give and unto my loving nephew Philip Audubert of the Island of Antigua, the sum of Three Hundred and pounds, Current of this Province, and also my Gold pointed Calasp, Six Pair of Silver Sacks, pair of Silver Knives, Six Silver and a Strainer, Six Silver Table Spoons, Silver Hatch pair Silver Buckles I am I give and devise unto my nephew Philip Audubert of Antigua aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever. All that my Black Mermaid House or Tenement together with the stand buildings and also the appurtenances thereto belonging situate lying and being and growing Southward, on the North side of Broad Street in Charles Town, aforesaid. I am I give and bequeath unto my loving niece Lydia Parrie, the Wife of Capt^m Robert Parrie of Boston, in New England aforesaid, and in case of her decease before mine leaving children or issue of her body surviving then and not otherwise to such children and issue and the survivors or survivor of them, at her, her or their several and respective ages of one and twenty years, or Marriages, which shall first happen, this to be equally shared and divided between them by my said Executors or Executor hereafter named the sum of Three Thousand pounds Current money of this Province and also my pair of Gold, Silver Buttons, six Silver Table Spoons, Six Silver Tea Spoons, and a Strainer in a Case, a large Silver Soup Spoon, a Silver punch Kettle, a Silver milk Pot, and a Silver Runch Strainer, and if she the said Lydia Parrie should die before me as aforesaid leaving such children or issue as aforesaid, then I will and direct my said Executors or Executor to put out and improve the said Legacy of Three Thousand pounds so intended for them or the survivors or survivor of them as aforesaid yearly and every year during the minority of such children, child or issue at Interest or Security for her or their use and behoof and to be paid and

and divided between them as herein before directed of and Concerning the Principal and in case of the death of the said Lydia Parrie, before mine, and for default of Children and issue of her body as aforesaid mentioned then and in case otherwise I further give and bequeath the said Legacy of Three Thousand pounds (Interest arising thereon if any) and Gold Buttons and silver plate to the said Capt^m Robert Parrie his Executors, Administrators and Assigns forever I am I give and bequeath unto my loving nephew Moses Audubert, son of my late Brother Philip Audubert deceased, the sum of two Thousand, seven hundred pounds, current money of this Province I am I give and bequeath unto my loving nephew, Benjamin Audubert of Boston aforesaid, the sum of two Thousand seven hundred pounds. Current money of this Province, to be paid out, at Interest, on good Security, yearly until his arrival to the age of twenty one years, and then Principal and Interest to be paid to him his Executors or Administrators by my said Executors hereinafter named or the survivors or survivor of them his Executors or administrators I am I will direct and empower my said Executors hereinafter named and the survivors and survivor of them, his Executors or administrators to sell and dispose of, for the most Monies, as he or they shall see fit, which monies together with all other my monies, Effects and personal Estate whatsoever, I give and bequeath unto my said Brother Benjamin Audubert of Boston aforesaid his Executors administrators or Assigns. Lastly I nominate constitute and Appoint Mess^{rs} John Savage, Benjamin Clark and James Payson of Charles Town aforesaid Merchants and my said nephew Philip Audubert of Antigua aforesaid Executors of this my said Last will and Testament and do hereby revoke annul and make void all former and other Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made or declared, and confirm and allow of this, and no other, to be and remain as and for my only Last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I the said Moses Audubert have hereunto set my hand and seal the seventeenth day of December in the Eighth year of the Reign of his Majesty King George the Third and in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven hundred and sixty four.

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Named, his Executors or administrators Item I give and bequeath unto my loving nephew Philip Audubert of the Island of Antigua, the sum of Three Thousand and four hundred current money of this Province, and also my Gold pointed Glass, Silver Mugs, pair of Silver Saets, pair of Silver Castors, six Silver Tea Spoons and a Strainer, six Silver Table Spoons, Silver Hatch, and a pair Silver Buckles Item I give and devise unto my said nephew Philip Audubert of Antigua aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that my Brick Messuage House or tenement together with the Land Buildings thereunto and also the appurtenances therunto belonging situate lying and being and growing Southward on the North side of Broad Street in Charles Town aforesaid Item I give and bequeath unto my loving niece Lydia Harris, the Wife of Capt^m Robert Harris of Boston, in New England aforesaid, and in case of her decease before mine bearing children or Issue of her body surviving then and not otherwise to such children and Issue and the survivors or survivor of them, at her, her or their several and respective ages of one and twenty years, or Marriages, which shall first happens, that to be equally shared and divided between them by my said Executors or Executors hereafter named the sum of Three Thousand Pounds current money of this Province and also my pair of Gold, Silver Buttons, six Silver Table Spoons, six Silver Tea Spoons, and a Strainer in a Case, a large Silver Soup Spoon, a Silver Pitch Kettle, a Silver milk Pot, and a Silver Pitch Strainer, and if the said Lydia Harris should die before me as above mentioned bearing such children or Issue as aforesaid, then I will and direct my said Executors or Executors to put out and improve the said legacy of Three Thousand Pounds so intended for them or the survivors or survivor of them as aforesaid yearly and every year during the minority of such children, child or Issue at Interest or Security for her or their use and behoof and to be paid and

In Witness whereof I the said Moses Audubert have hereunto set my hand and seal the fifteenth day of December in the Fifth year of the Reign of his Majesty King George the Third and in the year of our Lord Christ one Thousand seven hundred and sixty four.

In the Name of God amen, I John Sanson Mingo of the Parish of Christ Church in Berkeley County and Province of South Carolina being sick and weak in body but of perfect mind

and memory Thanks be to almighty God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all mankind once to die I do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows and first of all I recommend my soul into the hand of almighty God who gave it in hopes of a joyful resurrection and my body I recommend to the grave to be buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named, and now as to the settling of those my worldly goods that it hath pleased God to bestow on me I settle and bequeath as follows, Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Mingo two negroes, Women Named Kate and Jane all the household Goods of that kind sover a Riding Chain and two Chain Hooses, also one Silver Watch Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son John Mingo two negroes boys named Abram and Jack. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Sarah Mingo two Negroe girls named Ring and Bess. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son John Mingo all my lands and my wife to have a living on the said bequeathed Land during her life. Item I will that the remaining part of my negroes be sold if my Executors shall think proper, and the money arising from the sale of my Negroes sold, together with the money arising from the sale of my stock in general I will that it be Equally divided between my wife as aforesaid and my children, and I will that my children receive each their part of the said Estate at the age of twenty one years, and I will that their said monies shall be put to interest till then on good security but in case any one of my above named Children should die before he or she comes to the above age of ones and twenty years that then such Childs part shall be Equally divided between my loving wife aforesaid and the other surviving Child, but in case both my children should die then I will that both such Childrens parts shall go to my Wife aforesaid during her natural life and at her decease each part as she possessed as came by the death of my said children shall be Equally divided between my beloved Mother Mary Barasale and my beloved Brother Charvil Mingo. Lastly I nominate my beloved Brothers Charvil Mingo and Nathan Regare as my Executors and my beloved Wife Elizabeth Mingo as my
