 Body do make and ordain this to be my last will and
 Testament first of all I give and Recommend my soul into
 the Hands of Almighty God and as touching such worldly
 Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this
 life I give demise and Dispose of the same in the
 following manner first of all I will that all those
 Debts that I do owe in Right to be fully paid and Satisfied
 by my Exors after a convenient Time after my Decease.
 In witness my will and Desire is that my Beloved wife
 Priscilla (during her widowhood) have the use of my
 Plantation and Personal Estate just as she shall think
 will turn to the best advantage for the raising up and
 Maintenance of my poor children but if in case she should
 Marry. Then I give and Bequeath to her a Negro Wench
 Named Chloe a Mare by the Name Blossom and her
 Saddle and Bridle but immediately after she is married
 she my said Wife Priscilla is to have nothing to do with my
 Real and Personal Estate. Then my will and Desire is that
 all my ~~estate~~ Personal Estate should be kept together
 till my son George comes of age but in case my Wife
 should marry as she is to have nothing to do with my
 Real and Personal Estate then I leave it to the Discretion
 and Good Judgment of my two Exors herein after mentioned
 to do and to act as they'll think more beneficial for the use of
 my children. Item I give and Bequeath to my son George
 two hundred acres of land being a Part of the Tract of
 Land where I live upon to be according to the Course of the
 Plot beginning at a ~~Shinkapin~~ tree which is the Corner
 Opposite.

Opposite to the Standing and also the Remaining Part of Tract of
 Land Joining my Land & of which I have sold One Hundred and
 Twenty one acres to my brother John Hutchings and that to be
 for my son George and his heirs forever. Item I give and Bequeath
 to my son Nathaniel the remainder Part of all my Real Estate
 for him and his heirs forever but if in Case my Wife Priscilla
 continues a Widow till my son George is of age my will and Desire
 is that then all my Personal Estate to be equally divided between
 my wife and Children. Item my will and Desire is that each
 of my two sons Nathaniel and George when George is of age
 should pay or cause to be Paid to their Sister Mary the sums of
 One Hundred and Fifty Pounds Current money of South
 Carolina. Lastly I do hereby appoint constitute and Ordain
 my beloved Wife Priscilla my Coar in Robert Darrell and
 my friend Francis Deschamps as my sole Executors & Carers of
 this my last Will and Testament to do and to act as herein
 mentioned and I Confirm this to be my last Will and
 Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and Seal this Seventh Day of March in the year of our
 Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred fifty and two
