

I William Raiford of Broad River in the Province of South Carolina  
 being of sound mind and memory, do make this my Last Will and Testament  
 and dispose of my Estate in the following manner, I leave to Joseph Rees  
 a minor under my Guard my Plantation or Tract of land containing  
 Two hundred acres lying on the north side of the Congaree River, which  
 I purchased of Edward McGraw to him & his Heirs forever. I also man-  
 ner give and bequeath to my wife all the remainder of my Estate both real  
 and personal to her and her heirs forever - I hereby do nominate & appoint  
 my Friends John Pearson & Calixtus Long to be Executors of my wife Executrix  
 of this my Last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand & seal this twenty first day of December 1761

In the Name of God amew I Peter Reger the  
 Elder of Charles Town in the Province of South Carolina Cooper being sick  
 and weak in Body but of sound & disposing mind memory & understanding do  
 make & declare this my Last will and Testament in manner & form following  
 That is to say First I command my Soul to Almighty God my Creator  
 Hoping thro' His mercy and the merits of my saviour Jesus Christ I shall  
 enjoy eternal life, my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at  
 the discretion of my Executors hereafter named And as for that worldly  
 Estate which it hath pleased God to bless me with I give & dispose thereof  
 as followeth (that is to say) Imprimis I will that all my  
 just debts and funeral charges be first paid & satisfied Item I give  
 devise and bequeath to my loving wife Mary Reger to hold to her during  
 the term of her natural life all that my Dwelling House where I now  
 live situate lying and being in a street lane or alley commonly called or  
 known by the name of Redon's alley, together with all & singular the  
 houses outhouses and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any  
 wise appertaining; and from and immediately after her decease I give  
 devise and bequeath the same to my daughter Elizabeth Reger & to her  
 Heirs forever - Item it is my express will and I do hereby order and  
 direct that both those my two houses or tenements situate on the  
 east side of Church street shall be leased or hired out by my executors here-  
 after named and that the moneys arising therefrom shall be applied to  
 wards the payment of my debts and after the same are paid & satisfied  
 then I give devise and bequeath to my son Peter Reger all that my

my northermost house or tenement situate on the East side of Church street aforesaid and which said House is at present in the tenure or occupation of Doctor Robert Nelson To hold to him during the term of his natural life but in case of his decease without issue lawfully begotten then I give derive and bequeath the same to my daughter Elizabeth Regen & her Heirs Item I give and bequeath to John Ward of Charles Town merchant during the life of his now wife Rose Ward all that my southermost House or Tenement situate on the East side of Church street aforesaid; and after her death I give and derive the same to John Peter Ward Son of the said John Ward, but in case of his death before he shall attain the age of twenty one years or without issue lawfully begotten, then I give and bequeath the same to William Ward Second son of the aforesaid John Ward & to his Heirs & Assigns forever. Item I give to Thomas Wardell of Charles Town Cooper the sum of Two hundred pounds Current money - Item I give to Ann Beagley niece to Loring wife the sum of two hundred pounds Current money - Item it is my will and I do ordain & direct that what debts are due and owing me shall be collected immediately after my decease and that the moneys arising therefrom be applied by my executors towards the payment of my debts Item all the rest Residue and Remainder of my estate both Real and personal I give devise and bequeath to my loving Wife to hold to her during the term of her natural life and after her decease I give and bequeath the same to my daughter Elizabeth Regen and to her Heirs forever upon condition nevertheless that in case my debts should not be paid at the end of Expiration of two years after my decease then I order and direct that my executors hereafter named shall expose to sale and sell at public sale two third parts of my personal Estate and the moneys arising by such sale shall be applied towards the payment of my debts as aforesaid And partly I do here by make Ordain & appoint my loving wife Mary Regen Executrix and my good friend John Garage of Charles Town Esq<sup>r</sup> Executor of this my last will & Testament and I do revoke and make void all former and other wills by me heretofore made declaring this only to be my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and seal this Fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred Sixty One -
