 once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
 that is to say - Principally and first I give and recommend
 my soul into the hands of God that give it and my body to the earth
 to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors
 nothing doubting at the general Resurrection I shall recover the
 same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such
 worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life
 I dispose of the same in the following manner Ver -
 I desire that my Estate may be sold at publick sale as soon as
 possible after my decess both real and personal Except my horse saddle
 and bridel as also the best feather bed and furnitur and the best gun
 and marten accotermants which I give to my well beloved Son John
 Jarvis over and above his part after all my lawful debts and funeral
 Charges be paid Item I give and bequeath the use of one half of
 the residue of my estate to my well beloved daughter Marcy Harrey
 during her materel life and at her decess to be equally shared a-
 amongst her surviving children and the other half to my well beloved
 Son John Jarvis provided nevertheless that if my son John Jarvis
 should die before he arrives at the age of twenty one years or have
 issue, it is my will and pleasure that it should go to the surviving
 children of my aforesaid daughter Marcy Harrey to be equally shared
 and paid to them as they came of age or the day of Marcy and also
 it is my desire that Capt James Harroach should have the care of my
 son John Jarvis during his minority and also I do hereby revoke
 all former Wills and Testaments made by me & do hereby acknowledge
 this and no other to be my last will and Testament to the which
 I do hereby constitute appoint and ordain Capt James Harroach Executor
 of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness thereof thereunto
 do set my hand and seal this seventh day of Nov^r in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty two
