First I Bequeath my soul to almighty God in hopes that my Saviour & redeemer Jesus Christ will receive me into his heavenly mansions I leave & Bequeath to Ser^t John Bell all my Cloaths in Charles Town now in the possession of Mr. John Harvey I leave & Bequeath to my servant John Valentine Fifty pounds South Carolina Currency with all my Cloaths now in my House at Fort Prince George I likewise constitute & appoint ~~Rev~~ Laughlin Shaw to be my whole & sole Executor & order that he will receive my pay & arrears of pay that is in Mr Crafts hands & to pay my Creditors that he thinks will stand in most need. I likewise order that all my Books be given to Mrs. Mary Shaw wife of the above mentioned Laughlin Shaw I likewise Bequeath to Ser^t William Rowan my Gun & Pistol as also my Saddle & Furniture Broad Sword & Small Sword to the above mentioned John Bell to have my Silver Watch to Sergeant Daniels as Witness my hand seal Fort Prince George Cherokee Nation this 16th Day of February 1760.
